After threadbare discussions, the following resolutions were adopted unanimously.

ITEM NO 01: Proposal for Procurement against Capital Assets

RES. No. ASH/DAC/2020/01: all the members discussed to procure some essertial items for the department under capital assets and confirmed the list of item to be placed for approval from the competent authority, placed as annex 1.

ITEM NO 02: Time table

RES. No. ASH/DAC/2020/02:

The time table of 1st semester students will be remain same as last semester. However, some modification/rescheduling may be required in ongoing 3rd semester timetable, which will be communicated with the concerned department by the concerned faculty individually. Remedial class slots will be placed on the timetable for the 1st semester students who get marks below 50% in the internal examination. However, the same for the 3rd semester papers will process through the concerned department and a communication for the same will be made to the concerned HOD in advanced.

ITEM NO 01: Proposal for the recruitment of Guest faculty for the even semester courses

RES. No. ASH/DAC/20/2021/01: all the members discussed to recruit the guest faculty for the following courses. Since the department is a multidisciplinary and for there are no permanent faculty for the following courses. It has resolved to recruit the guest faculty as per the latest UGC guideline. ITEM NO 04: Proposal for Lab Setup

ITEM NO 05: Practical related

ASH/DAC/20/2021/05: Since all the courses of the ongoing semester (1st Semester have been conducted through online mode, so it has resolved to complete the practical classes of the course Engineering Physics lab through online mode. demonstrations of few practical will be shared with the students through video/pdf of manuals etc. and the examination of all practical will arranged through online.

ITEM NO 06: Open Elective (in 6th semester)

RES NO. ASH/DAC/20/2021/06: Dr. Arijita Pradhan, Faculty of English in ASH, proposed to initiate approval of the course "Communication and Language" (Coded as "HSMC LLG306" in AICTE curriculum 2017; document added) as the second option (the first approved option being "Understanding Society and Culture through Literature" ASH601) for Open Elective, which is mandatorily to be from Humanities as per the AICTE curriculum, prescribed for 6th semester of all departments. The faculty suggested the inclusion of this communication-skill based course as an option of open-elective after teaching the students who mostly came from regional medium, and considering the loss students have incurred during 2nd semesters of online teaching-learning. This 6th semester course will provide opportunity to the students to renew and hone their linguistic-skills after a gap of 2nd semesters, and will prepare them better for their ensuing professional career. Therefore, it has resolved to place the same as an agenda for next BUGS meeting of he department. Details syllabus is placed as annex 2.
