AND WHEREAS AUS and the CIDC wish to enter into an agreement (hereinafter referred to as "this Agreement") for the purpose of cooperating in the design and implementation of continuing and extension education programme(s) for professionals and construction workers respectively for the benefit of participants from India and abroad in conventional / distant mode of education.

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That both parties enter the Agreement with the objective to contribute to the development of human resources in the field of construction related activities through joint design and implementation, by AUS and CIDC for continuing and extension of education programme(s) for professionals and construction workers respectively (hereinafter referred to as "the programme(s)").
- 2. There shall be a Coordination Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") which-
 - (a) Would be the apex body to make recommendations on various aspects of credit based academic programme(s) for the approval of various statutory bodies of either party.
 - (b) Will have the Vice-Chancellor of AUS (or his nominee) and the Director General, CIDC (or his nominee) as the Chairman and Convener respectively of the Council.
 - (c) Will have six representatives (three nominated by each party).

This Coordination Council shall be constituted immediately upon signing of this Agreement. This Coordinator Council shall decide and take action in furtherance of this Agreement especially in following matters:

- (i) Agreement between AUS and CIDC in line with the working arrangement between CIDC & RGPV(Rajiv Gandhi Proudyogiki Vishwavidyalaya,Bhopal).
- (ii) Will determine the curriculum for the programme(s) upon the recommendations of the parties to this Agreement.
