It offers undergraduate programmes in Arts with honours courses in several disciplines and continues to broaden its academic scope through career-oriented and skill-based programmes. WHO CAN APPLY?

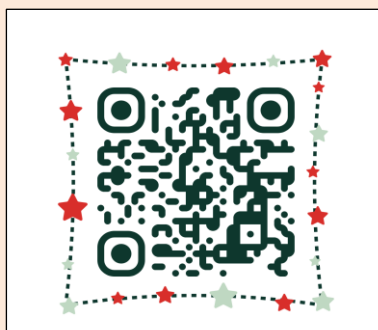
