ABOUT ICAUS

As part of deepening of engagement of Central Universities with local communities, an initiative from India's Rashtrapati Bhavan, the Innovation Club of Assam University, Silchar (ICAUS) was formed on May 13th 2013, and was inaugurated by the then Honorable President of India **Sri Pranab Mukherjee**. The Innovation Club of Assam University operates with twin objectives. One is mentoring, monitoring and supporting unaided grassroots innovations from the non-formal sector based on traditional knowledge developed by farmers, artisans, workshop mechanics, women and local communities.

The other is to support technological innovations in the formal sector wherein the onus is on the research scholars and the faculty of the University.

Innovations can be in machines, products for farm/non-farm operations, energy conservations, house hold utilities, agriculture, transportation, development of plant varieties, herbal traditional remedies, traditional knowledge related to alternative medicine and other low-cost sustainable green technologies. The idea is to bridge the gap between the local communities and the central institute of higher learning.

The key and immediate objective of the Innovation Club is to create awareness, educate, nurture and inculcate a culture of innovation amongst school/college students, local communities and to enable them to generate new ideas and become more innovative.

INNOVATION COMPETITIONS

School-Level Innovative Model Competition

Open to school students of Barak Valley. The Competition is in two categories -

Category 1 : Class IX & XCategory 2 : Class XI & XII

Each school will send one team of three members in each category. The teams will exhibit their model along with a poster presentation.

University-Level Innovative Idea Hunt Competition

Open to Masters Students & Research Scholars of Assam University as well as students of colleges

affiliated to Assam University, Silchar. It is an individual event and only one student from each department or college can apply for the Idea Hunt Competition. Each participant will be given five minutes time to present their 'innovative idea' to the panel of distinguished scientists, innovators and academicians. Projection facility will be provided for presentation.
