
- Women Empowerment- Myth or Reality?

The papers received within the stipulated date will be considered for publication. Submission of paper does not ensure publication as it would be subject to double blind peer review process. 

The preferred text format for papers is MS-Word. The length of the full Research Paper will be a within 1500 to 4500 words. Please type every portion of the manuscript double-spaced (a minimum of 6 mm between lines), including figure legends, table footnotes, and references, and number all pages in sequence, including the abstract, figure legends, and tables. The second page (main text) should contain an executive summary or abstract of no more than 150 words, and 3-5 keywords and JEL classification code. The main text subject matter should commence from second page onwards for anonymity (so that the referee will not know the identity of the author).

Authors are fully responsible for the accuracy of the data used in the manuscripts. If the manuscripts contain statistical analysis, the authors should provide supplementary notes (which will not be published) on the methods used in the analysis for the convenience of the referees. Statistical tables should be clearly titled and numbered and the reader should be able to understand clearly the meaning of each row or column. Units of measurement and sources of data should be clearly stated. The full mathematical workings (if any) necessary for justifying each step of the argument (which will not be published) should accompany the manuscripts of mathematical character to facilitate the referee's work. Diagrams should be clearly drawn (or generated) and labeled so that the reader would be able to understand its meaning.

Bibliographical references should be cited using the APA style. One person can contribute only one paper.
