Item No. 8: Allotment of Ph.D supervisor to Ms Archita Paul.

The chairman placed before the members the matter relating to allotment of Ph.D. supervisor to Mrs. Archita Paul. (All present in the meeting expressed their inability to guide her on the present area of research). The task of allotment of supervisor could not be undertaken in view of lack of relevant expertise at the present moment in the Department.

Item No. 09: Matter relating to discontinuation and cancellation of Title registration

- (i) The matter relating to application of Sri Prabhakar Dey for discontinuation of his Ph.D., research work, which was sent by him through e-mail, was placed before the members. The members discussed the matter and it was decided that his request for discontinuation may be accepted.
- (ii) The matter relating to the progress made by Mr. Juber Hussain Barbhuiya for his Ph.D., work was placed before the members. The members perused the report of the RAC of Mr. Juber Hussain Barbhuiya which was negative. After a threadbare discussion over the matter which suggested that the research scholar did not respond to the SMS and also the whatsapp messages sent by his supervisor, the members felt that since he has not been responding to the communications of his Ph.D., supervisor especially for incorporation of the suggestions made by the RAC concerned his title registration be cancelled as suggested by the RAC concerned also.
- (iii) The matter relating to Sri Kamal Kanti Das was also discussed. The fact that Sri Kamal Kanti Das was admitted in January 2019 and was exempted from course work as he possessed M.Phil., degree was brought to the notice of the members. As per rules he should have submitted his Ph.D., proposal for title registration within twelve (12) months from the date of his admission which he failed to do. Hence his admission stands cancelled as per A.U., Ordinance on M.Phil., & Ph.D., degree 2017 and Regulations concerned.

Item No. 10: Matter relating to correction in wrong bunching of one of the Marketing papers i.e., 403 (MR).

The matter relating to entry of the wrongly included contents in paper 403 MR was discussed. Since the two Departments i.e., Silchar and Diphu have been engaging classes on the contents as made available to them, which ideally should not have been in vogue, it was decided to continue

it that way *for this Semester*. However, the members felt that the rectification needs to be done by attaching the correct contents of the paper i.e., Consumer Behaviour: 403 (MR). This rectification, if allowed by the competent bodies like, BPGS, School Board and Academic Council etc., may be in vogue *from the next Semester*. A copy of the desired part of syllabi is attached, herewith, for appropriate comprehension.

Item No.11: Any other matter

No other matter was raised by any member and, therefore, the meeting ended with a vote of thanks from and to the chair.
