

5. All Candidates seeking admission in AUS-CIDC Programme have to register themselves with Assam University as per rule.

6. The conduct of qualifying examination shall be responsibility of the CIDC, which shall conduct the same in accordance with the standards set by the Council **in consultation and in presence of duly authorized representative of AUS, including the method of award of credit to individual participants, so as to bring transparency and credence to the entire system.**



7. The participants having passed the required examinations shall be awarded Certificates/ Degrees/ Diplomas by AUS. The Certificates/ Degrees /Diplomas will also bear the name and logo of the CIDC. The Certificate/ Degree/ Diplomas shall be in the format approved by the AUS. Further, **before awarding Certificates/ degrees/ Diploma to the eligible candidates they are to be examined by a group of experts nominated by both the institutes.**

The Co-ordination Council in its first meeting shall decide the format of certificate and authorized signatories of both parties authorized to sign the certificate/ Degree/ Diplomas with official seal of the respective organizations. All Certificates/ Degrees/ Diplomas shall be issued strictly in accordance with such authority.

8. The parties to the Agreement also agree to share the fee of the diploma programme in the ratio of **85:15** earning thereby that 85% of the revenue shall go to the CIDC while 15% of the same shall go the AUS. The parties shall keep their financial records in relation to the subject-matter of agreement to be clear, up to date and transparent. The mode of sharing would be reviewed from time to time.

9. Unless otherwise terminated by the written agreement between the parties, or in terms of this Agreement, this Agreement will remain in force for five years initially.

10. The parties hereto agree that as it is a joint venture of both parties to this MOU who shall put their maximum efforts in bonafidely manner to achieve the common goal. Notwithstanding the provisions of Clause 8, either party shall be entitled to terminate this Agreement immediately and without
