### ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

### REGISTRATION, SELECTION AND NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS

**The number of participant is 100 student youth** belonging either to Economically Deprived/Socially Disadvantaged and Excluded/Tribal/Rural/North East Youth. The students belonging to SC/ST or north-east from neighborhood Institutions, /NSS Volunteers/NYKS Volunteers may be included to the maximum extent possible.

The selection will be first come first basis. Last date for the registration of the participant is 10<sup>th</sup> March 2024. It is mandatory to enclose a photocopy of the community certificate (for SC/ST categories) along with the participant registration forms. ### HOW TO REACH DIPHU

There are regular trains departing from Guwahati, Dibrugarh, Jorhat, and Dimapur to the beautiful town of Diphu. Regular buses and frequent trains (as many as 13 trains per day) connect Diphu with the neighboring prominent towns, allowing tourists and travelers to visit without difficulty. Moreover, the train journey from Guwahati to Diphu is just four hours. There is less than a 45-minute travel time from Dimapur to Diphu. Dimapur airport is the closest airport. An excellent road transportation system also makes it easy to move to this area.

### **ABOUT THE HOST INSTITUTION**

Assam University, Silchar, Assam was established by an Act of Parliament promulgated in 1989(Act 13) and enforced by a notification of the Government of India on 21st January, 1994. The idea for a campus in Diphu originated during Professor J.B. Bhattecherjee's tenure as Vice Chancellor. On July 18, 2007, Professor Tapodhir Bhattacharjee, Vice-Chancellor of Assam University, inaugurated and launched the campus, which began operations with six departments. Diphu Campus currently contains ten academic departments and one centre. Anthropology, Assamese, Commerce, English, Geography, Hindi, History, Life Sciences, Physics, and Political Science are among the departments, with a Tribal Studies Centre attached to the Department of History. The permanent Campus is situated on 273 *bighas* of steep land allocated by the Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council. The Diphu campus is surrounded by lush green hillocks, ponds, and teak forest of Karbi Anglong, which is rich in eco-friendly environment. It is approximately 8 km from Diphu town towards Lumding Road. The peaceful backdrop distinguishes the Diphu Campus as one of exceptional natural beauty, capturing viewers' imaginations and providing an ideal environment for study and research. Since its beginning, the Campus has built a name for itself by providing several Post-Graduate courses and PhD programmes. Currently, Prof. Sivasish Biswas is serving as the Pro-Vice Chancellor for the Diphu Campus under the able direction and leadership of Prof. Rajive Mohan Pant, Hon' Vice Chancellor of Assam University, Silchar.

### **ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY**
