Guidelines for Filling up Part B of the Proforma

Part B of the Proforma is based on University Grants Commission (Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education) (4th Amendment), Regulations, 2016.

1. General

1.1 Any student related activity (under all categories) which requires visit to other place/institute (e.g., taking the students for Field work, study visit etc.), the travel period (to and fro) can be added along with the time spent in the actual activities for calculation of score of the concerned teacher(s).

2. Category I: Teaching, Learning and Evaluation Related Activities

- 2.1 For computation of API score for the components under '*Direct Teaching*' [1 (a)], the actual hours as per record to be provided.
- 2.2 The time that can be claimed for various Examination duties [1 (b)] is as follows:
 - i) For *Question paper setting/Moderation* (each full paper), 3 hrs for UG pass/ Honours or equivalent and 5 hrs for PG/Course work Exam or equivalent. For setting or moderation of part of one question paper, the claimable time will be the equivalent fraction of time as per the contribution or 50% of the time for full paper, whichever is higher.
 - ii) For *Invigilation, Practical Examination (Internal/External)* duties, actual hours as per record to be claimed.
 - iii) The claimable time for *Evaluation/Re-evaluation* of answer script is minimum 5 hrs per Paper (Packet) or 30 min per answer script whichever is higher.
 - iv) 25% of the time applicable for Evaluation of that Paper can be claimed by the *Scrutiniser*.
- 2.3 Innovative Teaching Learning, an integral component of teaching-learning process requires time for proper planning, and consultation with books/literature. Most of such activities requires time outside of, and in addition to the assigned teaching time allotted. Hence, the actual number of hours equal to that spent for Lectures (in I a) can be claimed under 'Innovative Teaching Learning' [1 (c)].

3. Category II: Professional Development, Co-curricular and Extension Activities

- 3.1 A faculty is required to keep a record of the Student related activities for claiming score for components laid in II(a) of the proforma and can claim actual hours for each event under II (a) (i and ii and iii).
- 3.2 For administrative responsibility like Dean of School or Head of the Department, a fixed time 2hours/week can be claimed for API score, for the entire tenure or part of tenure, whichever falls within the assessment year. For each of the other administrative responsibilities assumed by a faculty, under the purview of II.b(i) of the proforma, a fixed time of 1hour/week for the entire tenure or part of tenure, whichever falls within the assessment year can be claimed for API score.

- 3.3 For participation in various Board of Studies, Academic and Administrative Committees, a faculty can claim a fixed time of 1hour/week (for each of such participation) for the tenure/part of tenure of the Committee falling within the assessment year for API score.
- 3.4 The starting and ending time of every meeting related to the academic and/or administrative affairs is to be recorded in a suitable manner in the Meeting Register and/or in the Minute of the Meeting to facilitate the reflection of the credit in the API of the faculty members involved. For participation in each such meeting, a minimum of two hours plus block of one hour (for each additional hour or part thereof) can be claimed by the Faculty member. This will be in addition to the score obtained for 3.2 and 3.3 mentioned above.
- 3.5 The API Score for participation in seminar/conferences, short term training courses, (II. c) will be counted taking 7 hours X (total number of days of the event as per record). However, in case of visit to industry/other institution/laboratory, API score may be counted taking 24 hours X (total number of days as per record).
- 3.6 The API Score for Lectures delivered in Refresher courses/Orientation Programs/ Faculty Development programs and workshops (II.c), will be counted taking 7 hrs X (total number of days of actual involvement as per record).
- 3.7 For each contribution of Dissemination and general articles a fixed time of 24hrs can be claimed in API score.

4. CATEGOR III: Research and Publications and Academic Contributions

- 4.1 Papers published in journals notified in the UGC website or any subsequent list approved by the UGC. The University shall identify the journals subject-wise and forward it to the UGC for approval. The list of such journals shall be available in the University web-site as well.
- 4.2 The API Score awarded per paper in a Refereed journal as notified by the UGC shall be 25 for single author. Wherever relevant to any specific discipline, the API score for paper in refereed journal would be augmented as follows: (i) paper with impact factor less than 1 by 5 points; (ii) papers with impact factor between 1 and 2 by 10 points; (iii) papers with impact factor between 2 and 5 by 15 points; (iv) papers with impact factor between 5 and 10 by 20points: (v) papers with impact factor above 10 by 25 points. For other reputed journal as notified by the UGC, the Score awarded per paper shall be 10 for single author.
- 4.3 The score for (i) Text/Reference Books (published by International Publishers with ISBN/ISSN number as approved by the university and posted in the website) is 30 per Book for Single Author, (ii) Subject books published by (national-level publishers or central/state govt publications with ISBNISSN number as approved by the university and posted in the website) is 20 per Book for Single Author, (iii) Subject books published by (local publisher with ISBNISSN number as approved by the university and posted in the website) is 15 per Book for Single Author, (iv) Chapter in books published by (national and international level publishers with ISBNISSN number as approved by the university and posted in the website) is 10 per chapter for international publication and 5 per chapter for national publication for single author.
- 4.4 The API for joint publications shall be calculated in the following manner: For joint publication, the first and principal/corresponding author/supervisor/mentor would share equally 70% of the total points and the remaining 30% would be shared equally by the rest.

- 4.5 For faculty members of Science/ Engineering/ Agriculture/ Medical/ Veterinary Sciences major project grants above Rs. 30 lakhs shall have 20 score, between Rs. 5 lakhs and Rs. 30 lakhs shall have15 score per project and for minor research projects between Rs. 1 lakh and Rs. 5 lakhs shall have 10 score per project. For faculty members of Languages/ Humanities/ Arts/ Social Sciences/ Library/ Physical Education/ Management Major project grant for above Rs. 5 lakhs shall have 20 score, between Rs. 3 lakhs and Rs. 5 lakhs shall have 15 score and minor projects between Rs. 1 lakh and Rs. 3 lakhs shall have 10 score per project.
- 4.6 For faculty members of Science/ Engineering/ Agriculture/ Medical/ Veterinary Sciences 10 marks shall provided for every Rs. 10 lakh earned through Consultancy Projects. For faculty members of Languages/ Humanities/ Arts/ Social Sciences/ Library/ Physical Education/ Management 10 marks shall be provided for every Rs. 10 lakh earned through Consultancy Projects.
- 4.7 For faculty members of Science/ Engineering/ Agriculture/ Medical/ Veterinary Sciences 30 marks shall provided for patent/technology transfer/product/process for international level and 20 for each national level output/ outcome. For faculty members of Languages/ Humanities/ Arts/ Social Sciences/ Library/ Physical Education/ Management 30 marks shall provided for preparing major policy document of international bodies like WHO/ UNO/ UNESCO/ UNICEF, etc. 20, 10 and 5 marks shall be provided for preparing major policy document prepared for Central Government, State Government and Local bodies respectively.
- 4.8 For Research Guidance, in case of M.Phil, the API score is 5 per student if the degree is awarded and no score shall be counted for submission of M.Phil. Thesis. In case of Ph.D. guidance, API score of 15 per student can be claimed if the degree is awarded and 10 per student for Ph.D. thesis submitted. The API Score for Research Supervisor and Co-Supervisor(s) if any, will remain the same.
- 4.9 For international award/fellowship, API score shall be 15; it will be 10 for national award/ fellowship and 5 for state/ university level award/ fellowship.
- 4.10 For international conference/seminar API score shall be 7 per Invited lecture and 5 per paper presented. For national conference/seminar API score shall be 5 per Invited lecture and 3 per paper presentation. For state/ university level conference/ seminar API score shall be 3 per Invited lecture and 2 per paper presented. The score for paper presented (other than Invited Lecture) in any seminar/ conference shall be same for all the authors of the paper. (The score in this category shall be restricted to 20% of the minimum fixed for category III for any assessment period)
- 4.11 For Development of e-learning delivery process/material, the API score shall be 10 per module.

These guidelines are applicable only for the candaidates who will apply as per UGC 2016 Regulations. For others, the previous guideline will prevail.

Formula for Computing the Scores in three Categories of the Proforma

Part B (Category I)

- 2. The maximum score that can be claimed under category I a. for Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Professor are 70, 60 and 60 respectively.
- 3. The maximum score that can be claimed under category I b. for Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Professor are 20, 20 and 10 respectively.
- 4. The maximum score that can be claimed under category I c. for Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Professor are 10, 15 and 20 respectively.
- 5. The formula for calculating the actual score to be claimed under category I a. is for Assistant Professor $\left(\frac{\text{Sub total I a.}}{7.5}\right)$, Associate Professor $\left(\frac{\text{Sub total I a.}}{7.75}\right)$ and Professor $\left(\frac{\text{Sub total I a.}}{7.75}\right)$
- 6. The formula for calculating the actual score to be claimed under category I b $\left(\frac{Sub total\ I\ b.}{10}\right)$
- 7. The formula for calculating the actual score to be claimed under category I c $\left(\frac{Sub total\ I\ c.}{10}\right)$
- 8. Evidence of performing the duties is to be provided wherever applicable.

9. The formula for actual scores to be claimed under category II a. is $\left(\frac{\text{Sub - total II a.}}{10}\right)$, II b. is $\left(\frac{\text{Sub - total II b.}}{10}\right)$ and II c. is $\left(\frac{\text{Sub - total II c.}}{10}\right)$
