

- (iii) Define the eligibility criteria for the personnel for joining the programme(s).
- (iv) Fix the duration of the study period for different level of personnel.
- (v) Decide the mode of offering structured training in the field of construction related areas in the given context.
- (vi) Make out the schedule (duration of the course) of the study programme(s).
- (vii) Lay down guidelines for preparation of course materials for different groups.
- (viii) Will decide modus operandi for popularization of the programme(s).
- (ix) Identify Constituent Institutes (CIs) Partnering Institute (PIs) in different locations.
- (x) Will identify councilors and instructors for extending constant guidance to the students.
- (xi) Will undertake further development of the programmes/ centres etc. and also shall draw out the budget for expenditure and decide the responsibilities of two signatories of the agreement. It is agreed that all existing Centres run by CIDC shall be for the purposes laid down in this Agreement, become authorized Centres and shall be automatically recognized as such by the First Party.

3. The members of the Council shall serve for a term of five years. However, any member of the Council can be changed at the discretion of the nominating institutions. On expiry of this agreement a fresh co-ordination council may be constituted or existing council may continue if both the parties to this agreement agree.

4. The Council shall meet at the invitation of the Chairperson or at the request of one of the parties to the Agreement. The quorum for the conduct of the Council's business any of such meeting shall be at least one representative from each party. Subject to the respective approval of the nominating institutions, the Council may adopt other rules for the conduct of its business in such meetings. Atleast meeting twice in a year should be organized.
