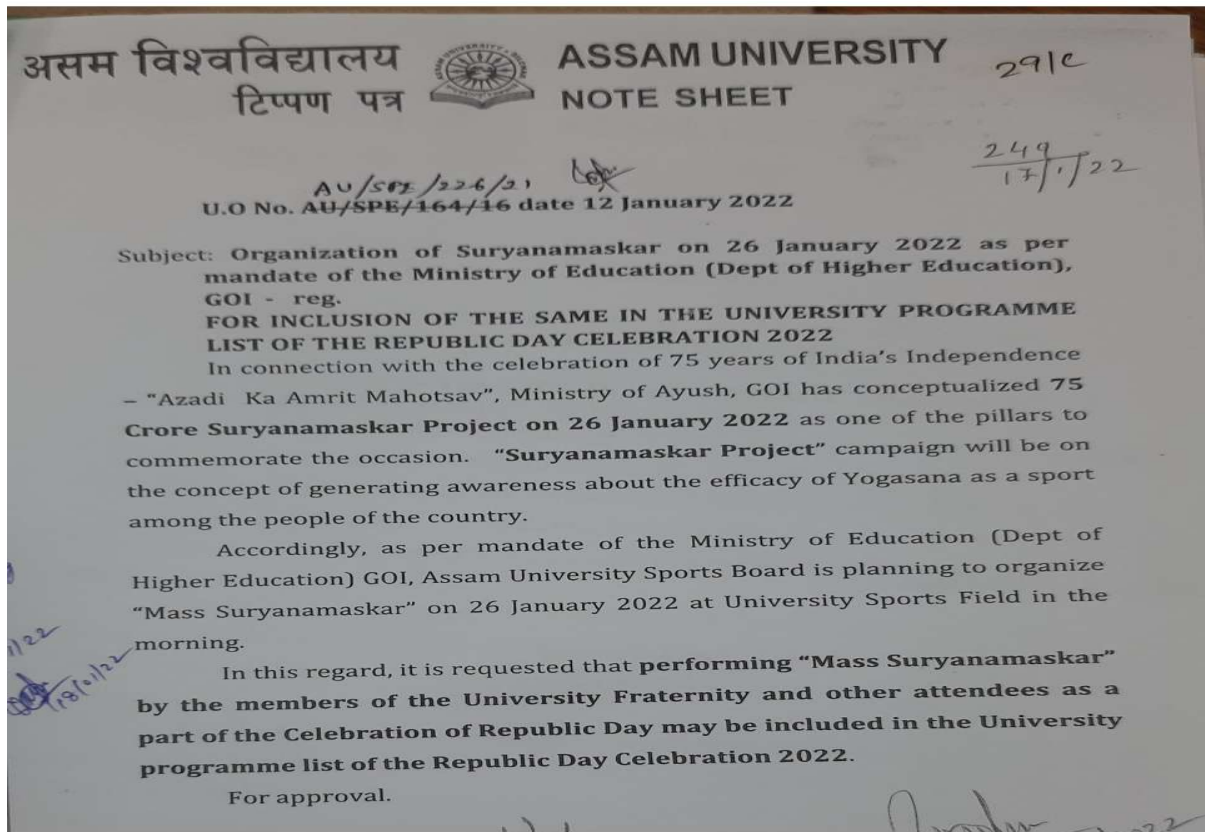

This contractual term of engagement will not give him any right for claiming regular employment in the Assam University, Silchar in future and shall **stand terminated automatically after the expiry of the above period.**







The meeting was held with a broad objective to assess the requirements for development of Sports with regards to both short and long term measures in the University.
At the very outset, the Vice Chancellor welcomed the members of the Sports Board and urged the members to give their suggestions and inputs for the development of sports in the University. Thereafter, Member Secretary gave brief background about the activities of the Sports Board.
It was informed by the Director (Sports Board) that the Board is making continuous efforts to create sports environment in the campus and appraised about the steps being taken by the Board in augmenting the level of sports in the University. After threadbare discussion on several issues pertaining to Sports, the following resolutions were adopted.

Item No. 1: Construction of Indoor Stadium for multipurpose activities
The Director (Sports Board) informed about the urgent need of the construction of an Indoor Stadium to support the students and staff to hone their skills and excel in different indoor sports events.
Regarding construction of Indoor Stadium, it was informed that proposal for Indoor Stadium with a project estimate of ₹ 9,92,64,650.00 has been approved in the 99th Building Committee Meeting and the proposal is pending as funds need to be provided.

Resolution:
SB:22-02-22:01: The proposal is approved. It was decided that the Indoor Stadium may be constructed on priority basis. For this project, the funding of ₹ 9.93 crore may be made out of ₹ 25 crore allocation announced recently (January 2022) by the Chief Minister of Assam.
