Special Terms

Terms defined in this Schedule 1 shall have the same meanings when used throughout this Agreement.

For the purposes of the Project and the Grant, the terms of this Agreement shall prevail over any other terms and conditions issued by the British Council (whether on a purchase order or otherwise).

1 The Project

1.1 The British Council awards the Grant for the purposes of conducting an independent research on the topic selected by the researcher 'An Investigation into the Relationship between Mother Tongue and English Language Learning Strategies among High School Students in Southern Assam' as part of English language teaching research mentoring scheme (ELTRMS) as more fully described in the Project Proposal (Schedule 2) (the "Project").

2 Commencement and Duration

- 2.1 This Agreement shall come into force on 25 March 2019, the Project shall commence on 26 March 2019 (the "Project Start Date") and this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect until 31 March 2020. (the "Term").
