Sir,

1. I am directed to refer to this Department's letter of even No. dated 01.08.2013 conveying the Administrative Approval for the implementation of the above project at total outlay of Rs. 32.616 lakh (Rupees thirty two lakh sixty one thousand and six hundred only) as grant-in-aid for a period of 24 months.

2.
