To start with, the Convener addressed the audience with a welcome address mentioning the need for such an interactive programme along with its context and importance. The teachers of the department were all present on the occasion and were invited serially to address the students and motivate them during these pandemic times.

To start with, Professor Sumanash Dutta welcomed all the 1st semester students formally to Assam University, Department of Economics with deeply thought out words of assurance and motivation. He stressed on the importance of higher education and the fact that students are and shall remain as assets to the institution. He hoped that very soon we would all be able to restore our normal system of classes in off-line mode. Prof. Dutta reminded students that the AUS campus is not only renowned for its picturesque beauty but is unmatched perhaps by any university campus in the country. That is in fact a strong enough reason to visit the campus and embrace it.

Prof. Niranjan Roy after welcoming the students' harped upon the need for them to be well behaved good citizens who could meaningfully work towards nation building. Citing the

ideology of Netaji (as it was the birth Anniversary of NetajiSubhash Chandra Bose) Prof. Roy motivated the new comers with words of inspiration. He reminded the audience that students of the department were undoubtedly the mostwell-mannered and well-behaved in the campus.

Prof. Alok Sen welcomed the students with words od wisdom and advise. He stressed upon the need for pursuing quality education and also the fact that the nation needed skilled work force or an employable work force. He reminded the new comers that the university system is a very different system and that they would have to quickly adapt to the new educational environment.

Prof. Mahmood Ansari welcomed the student and felt sorry for the fact that the meeting had to be held in an online mode due to the on-going pandemic. He stressed upon the very importance of learning that adds value and learning that wipes out all wrong concepts and ideas acquired previously due to faulty educational environments. He emphasised on the need for an all-round development of a student with specific attention to physical, cultural, and social activities, such that he or she can turn out to be a vibrant human being with unbiased knowledge about his or her surroundings.

Dr.RajuMandal motivated the students and welcomed them through his speech. He also stressed upon the need to adapt to the new scenario in the university system which is harshly different from a college system. Dr.Avijit Debnath welcomed the students and motivated them to be regular with their curricular activities. He wished them good health and advised them to take maximum safety precautions necessary during this period when a second phase of infections are already known to have occurred. He emphasised the need to stay physically fit by means of yoga and other physical activities. Dr.Manash Roy after welcoming the students reminded them that they have entered a new system, a new area and a new phase that could be a game changer in their lives. He asked them to be very regular with all academic tasks and activities so that there are no backlogs in learning. He motivated all students to be conversant in English such that learning can be enhanced and furthered. He hoped to interact with the students in an offline mode in the coming months.

The IQAC Department level co-ordinator then invited the newly admitted MA students of the department to speak a few words on the occasion of the Induction Programme. Five students expressed their immediate willingness to speak on the occasion and were invited serially by the programme convener. 


Report of the Induction Programme

The Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Assam University, Silchar organized a virtual Induction program for the fresh entrants to the B. Pharm course. The objective of this program was to acclimatize the students to the new environment and get them acquainted with the Institution culture in general and specifically the Pharmacy profession.


The Programme started at 11:00 am dated 19th October 2020 via Google Meet. A total of 33 students and the Faculty members were present for the function. Dr Ram Kumar Sahu, Assistant Professor, the co-ordinator of the program welcomes the audience and presented a brief introduction of Professor Sanjib Das, Head, Department of Pharmaceutical Science. Professor Sanjib Das addressed the participated students and gave them a detailed introduction of the Pharmacy Department, its functions, and scope of Pharmacy. He also gave a brief description about the courses offered by the Department, ongoing activities, the achievements of students, importance of academic calendar and timely completion of the course, the conduct of examination and evaluation, etc. He also introduced the various faculty members of the Department.

1. The programme was initiated by programme co-ordinator who welcomed all participants, and read out the programme schedule.

Proceedings of the First Induction Program, of the Department of Statistics, Assam University, Silchar held on 24.12.2020 at 6:30 PM (online mode)

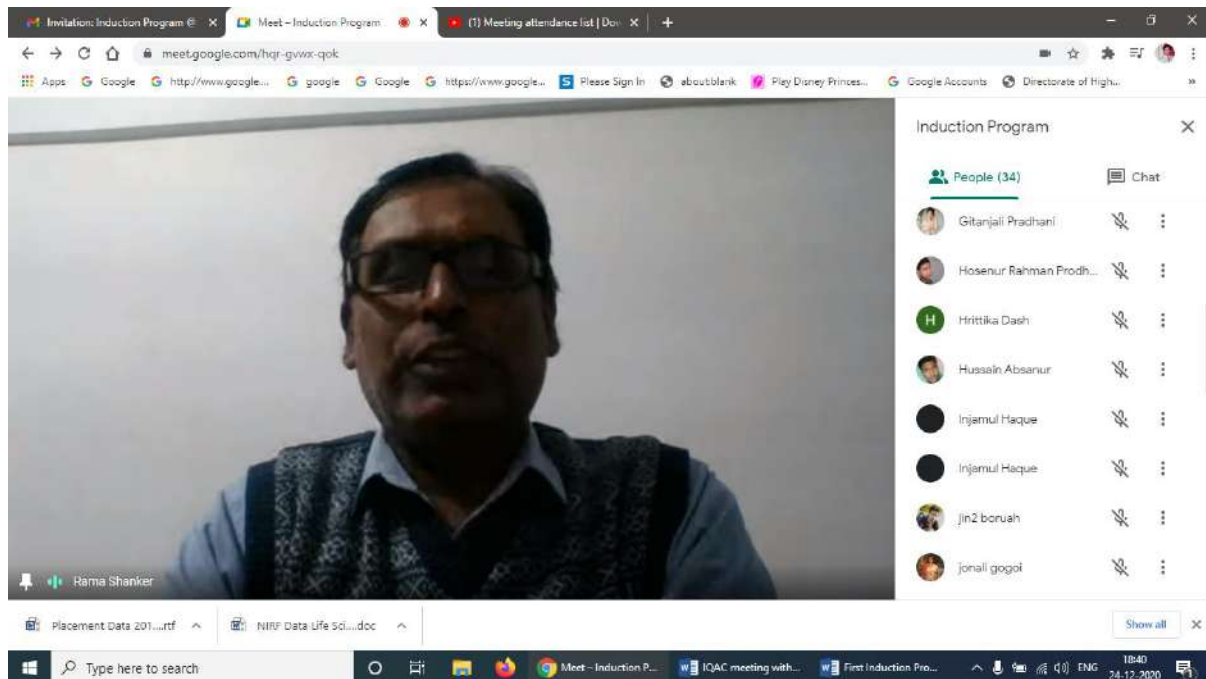



- 2) The members also discussed about the distribution of the papers which are to be taught to the 1st semester students.


Report of the Induction Programme conducted through virtual mode.

1. Report on the Induction Programme for Students of M.A. (1st Semester)




