At the outset, the Chairman, School Board of Swami Vivekananda School of Library Sciences, welcomed all the School Board members. The Chairman then initiated discussions as per agenda items notified by Notification AU/SVSLC/107/2013/ 580-92 Dated January 29, 2021, of the meeting issued earlier. The Chairman welcomed all the External and Internal Members of the School Board. He requested them to help the SVSLSc for the development of a conducive academic environment in the University.

After item-wise discussion, the following resolutions were taken along with important observations.

22: SB: SVSLSc: 11-02-2021:1Confirmation of the Minutes of 21^{st} School Board meeting held on 3^{rd} March 2020;

The Chairman read out the minutes of the 21st School Board meeting held on March 3, 2020. Since there were no comments, the note of descent received from any of the members on the resolutions adopted, the said minutes stand as confirmed.

Matter related to the Approval of Panel of Paper Setters, Examiners, Moderators and Subject Experts for Practical Examinations of 1st and 3rd Odd Semester Examinations, December 2020 (Scheduled to be held in February 2021 and April 2021 for 3rd and 1st Semester respectively);

The HoD & Chairman, BPGS, submitted the Panel of Paper Setters, Examiners, Moderators, and Subject Experts for PG Odd Semester Practical Examinations, December 2020 (Exam to be held in February 2021 & April 2021) for 1st and 3rd Semester respectively, in sealed cover for consideration.

As this is a routine matter, the committee members considered and recommended forwarding the same in the sealed cover to the Chairman, Academic Council for consideration and onward forwarding to the higher body for approval.

The Head of the Department and the Chairman, BPGS, placed the two cases of Title Registration Seminar Presentation Reports recommended by the RAC Meeting and the DRC meeting held on 29/09/2020. The same has been duly recommended and forwarded by the BPGS with some modifications in the School Board title for consideration and onward forwarding to the BRS and other higher bodies for approval.

The HoD also placed the subject experts' reports on the two number synopsis submitted by two Ph.D. Research Scholars viz., Ms. Nilanjana Purkayastha and Mr. Rajesh Chutia. The Subject Experts have given favorable reports with minor modifications in Title and objectives in the case of Ms. Nilanjana Purkayastha's synopsis and Mr. Rajesh Chutia's Synopsis.

The School Board Members deliberated on the Subject Experts and BPGS Members' modifications in the Synopsis's Titles of two scholars.
