Draft Proposal to Conduct Online Final Semester / Back Papers (2^{nd} Semester) Examinations for the Department of Library and Information Science , AUS

In view of Minutes of the 4th Standing Academic Council Meeting decisions circulated vide F. No. AUR/21-1/2020/41 Dated: 25.08.2020, in which it has been mentioned that the department may go for conducting Online Examination, if feasible in existing infrastructure and the concerned department should prepare the modalities of the online exam and notify after obtaining vetting from the Controller of Examinations.

Draft Guidelines and Modalities to Conduct Online Examination of End Semester

Following is the draft guidelines and modalities to conduct Terminal Semester Examination as per the decision taken in the 58^{th} Departmental Affairs Committee Meeting held on 28/08/2020 at 12.10 P M through Online mode using Microsoft MS-Teams platform :

- ➤ The Department of Library and Information Science decided to hold Terminal Semester Examination in Online Mode :
- ➤ No candidates are available for back paper ;
- ➤ The students are required to keep their Laptop/ Mobile Phone ready with full charged battery and proper Internet connectivity;
- The students should also make necessary arrangement of alternative power supply back up;
- > Students will be required to sit in front of camera in switch on mode using Microsoft MS Teams / Google Meet Platform and start writing the exam;
- ➤ The students should write their answer in either one side of A4 size paper or purchase a long copy having good quality paper so that there will be no problem in scanning / taking photographs of the sheets;
- > Students are advised to write their Roll No on each page of the answer scripts/ Answer Copy;
- After completion of the examinations, the students are advised to send their all duly signed hand written answer scripts to the HoD by Speed Post for record and reference;
- In the Terminal Semester Examination, there will be 10 descriptive questions (long answer type) in traditional way as available in the printed question papers, out of which, the students have to attempt any five questions irrespective of the Units;
- ➤ The Examination Dept. will supply question papers to the Dean of School in advance as per usual practice;
- ➤ Before 10 minutes of the commencement of Examination, the Dean of School will show the question paper packet in front of camera and open the question paper in presence of the Faculty Members and students. After opening of question paper packet, one question will be taken out which will be scanned or photographs will be taken by the Dean through mobile;
- ➤ Then the scanned copy / photographs of question paper will be sent to the Final Semester Students either by e-mail or through WhatsApp Group immediately before the commencement of examination;
- After completion of exam at 1.00 P M, the candidates will be given 25 minutes extra time for scanning of all pages in continuous manner and make PDF file using the available technology;

- After making PDF, it is named after the Name / Roll No of the Candidate to be submitted by e-mail/ WhatsApp to the HoD.
- ➤ HoD, will later on forward this mail to the concerned examiner for evaluation of the scripts along with marks file and remuneration bill;
- ➤ The answer scripts after evaluation will be moderated and final marks will be submitted to the Exam branch for uploading of marks files and finalising the results.
- For the Practical examinations, the concerned Course Teacher has already given demonstration for hands on practice using Online Mode and each students are required to write Project Report and get it Spiral Bind if possible and the Scanned / PDF File should be submitted to the concerned Course Teacher through e-mail with a copy to the HoD (mksproject2020@gmail.com);
- For Practical Examinations for paper LISCC-402 and LISCC-404 (Dissertations), one External Examiner will be invited as per the Panel Submitted by the HoD to the Chairman, Academic Council with a copy to the CoE. For which the appointment letters for External Examiners are to be issued by the CoE Office after the notification of the exam schedule.
- The students are required to present their practical paper through PPT and Viva-Voce in presence of External and Internal Examiners;
- ➤ The External Examiners will submit marks file to the HoD through e-mail and HoD will finalise the average marks taking marks files from the Internal and External Examiners as per existing exam guidelines;
- ➤ Dr. Nabin Chandra Dey, Assistant Professor of the Dept has been given the charge of Departmental P G Examination Coordinator who will coordinate all the work in consultation with HoD and Dean of the School:
