- 2. The IPP course work should be from the same department
- 3. In case School Board considers the matter favourably, she can only register for PH.D as a regular candidate after obtaining leave from her parent organization (Assam Gramin Vikash Bank)
- 4. Part time research facility is extended to regular teachers of affiliated colleges of Assam University only.

  All the members unanimously felt that such practice should be discouraged.
