

# ASSAM UNIVERSITY: SILCHAR NOTIFICATION

On the recommendation of University Admission Committee, 2022 and as approved by the Vice Chancellor, it is notified that the following guidelines will be followed for Admission to PG Courses 2022-23 (both Silchar & Diphu Campus).

1. \* Schedule for admission related activities: (For Silchar Campus only)

Approval of applications by the Department	Up to 11th November, 2022
Admit Card Generation	14th November, 2022
Entrance Test (written) & PI	16th to 18th November 2022
Entry of Composite score by department into the	21st November, 2022
Admission Portal form HoD panel	
Publication of 1st Merit list	25th November, 2022
Admission of selected students from 1st list	25th to 27th November, 2022
Commencement of 1st Semester classes	28th November, 2022

## \*For Diphu Campus separate schedule will be notified by PVC, i/c Diphu Campus.

- 2. The Department shall approve the application forms pending the TDC end semester marks, if any.
- 3. Applicants claiming reservation benefit need to submit their Caste Certificate released by the Govt. of India. Those belonging to OBC category must submit valid Noncreamy Layer Certificate as per the Govt. of India format. Those applying under Economically Weaker Section (EWS) category must submit valid Income & Asset Certificate issued by the appropriate authority in the prescribed format of the GOI.
- 4. The Entrance Test (Written and PI) for different courses will be conducted as per schedule furnished at annexure- A. The test will be conducted at the two campuses of Assam University. The candidates who have applied for admission into Silchar campus will appear entrance test at Silchar campus only and those applied for Diphu campus shall appear in entrance test at Diphu campus only.
- 5. The written test will be of one hour duration with maximum marks 50 only. Multiple Choice Questions with four alternatives will be the preferred pattern. Respective departments at both campuses shall manage the Entrance Test including question papers(s).
- 6. The personal interview shall be conducted for a maximum of 25 marks only.
- 7. The following weightage scheme shall be followed:

  Qualifying Examination: Written Test: PI = 25:50:25
- 8. Applicants completing their graduation from colleges affiliated to Assam University and seeking admission into PG program will get a weightage equivalent to 30% of the aggregate percentage of marks secured in the qualifying examination.
- 9. Candidates seeking admission into P.G. program with Honours/Major subjects at Under Graduate level will attract another weightage equivalent to 10% of aggregate percentage of marks secured in the Honours/Major subject.
- 10. ST (H) candidates of the State of Assam applying for admission in Diphu Campus, will be given Special Weightage equivalent to 20% of aggregate percentage of marks secured in qualifying examination.
- 11. A candidate applying for a particular PG program but has not studied the concerned subject with Honors / Pass at the Under Graduate level (in case permitted), then the aggregate percentage of marks of both Pass and Honors (in case of Honors student) or aggregate Pass marks (in case of Pass students) shall be considered for the additional award of 30% provided the candidate has completed his / her Graduation from colleges / institutes affiliated to Assam University.

- 12. A calculation sheet for award of weightage and merit to candidate as per details mentioned at serial 8, 9, 10 and 11 above is being provided at Annexure B for ready reference.
- 13. All the candidates appearing entrance test are compulsorily required to submit self attested copies of their class 10 (High School), 10+2 (Intermediate) and 10+2+3 (UG) examination mark sheets at the time of PI. They are required to produce all their testimonials in original for verification.
- 14. After downloading Admission forms the respective departments shall conduct Entrance Test and all related activities like short-listing of candidates for entrance, printing of Question Papers, Evaluation of Answer Scripts, Conducting of Personal Interview, Computing of Composite Courses of the candidates and uploading the same in the HoDs panel etc.
- 15. All expenses concerning Entrance Examination shall be born out of the Application Fees collected from the Candidates and not from the Departmental Course Fee. For the purpose, the HoD may claim maximum Rs. 5000/- or (number of applicants× Rs. 60/-),or minimum Rs.1000/- whichever is applicable for concerned department from the competent authority through a proposal giving detail budget.
- 16. A student can apply maximum in two courses either in the same Department or in different Departments. However, he/she has to deposit fees for each application. Respective Departments conducting online test & PI should avoid time overlap in respect of such cases.
- 17. A student shall not apply simultaneously in Departments located at two different campuses.
- 18. A Departmental Admission Committee shall be formed in each Department and approval of the same may be obtained from the competent authority as per practice. One faculty member belonging to SC/ST category is to be included in the Departmental Admission Committee. In case there is no faculty member of SC/ST category available in the Department, any faculty member of SC/ST category from the same school may be included in the Departmental Admission Committee.
- 19. Reservation of seats for SC, ST, OBC( NCL) , EWS and PwD with valid certificates will be made as 15%, 7.5%, 27%, 10% and 5% respectively as per seat matrix published in the Admission prospectus.
- 20. The Liaison Officer, SC/ST Cell, AUS through SC/ST representatives of the different Departmental Admission Committees shall monitor the overall implementation of reservation policy of GOI in the matter of Admission into PG courses.
- 21. Issues, if any, concerning the admission portal (https://www.ausexamination.ac.in/admission) may be resolved by the department in consultation with Mr. Sobhan Kumar Bedajna, System Analyst, COE Office, AUS.

- (a) **Hall Ticket/Admit card** will be forwarded to the approved candidates by 14<sup>th</sup> November 2022. The candidates can download/printout the Hall Ticket/Admit card from their registered email id and applicant login.
- (b)**Personal Interview(PI)** to be conducted by the concerned Department on the same day of the Admission Test or as per convenience.
- (c) In case, Department -wise time schedule for the **Entrance Test overlaps**, concerned HOD shall collect the question paper from the Second Department and allow the candidates to appear for that subject providing additional one hour time. Answer script of Second Entrance test should be sent to the concerned department in a sealed envelope immediately after completion of the test.
- (d) The Departments shall enter the "COMPOSITE SCORE" of the qualified candidates in the admission portal from the HOD panel by 21st November 2022 following the same procedure as was in case of Ph.D admission.
