Report on the Action Taken on the Students' Feedback on Online Teaching

Assessment and Observation

The DAC meeting discussed, assessed and analyzed the Students' feedback on online teaching,

prepared and compiled by IQAC. The meeting is of the opinion that that the feedback on online

teaching categories such as 'ability, coverage, uniformity, clarity, interaction, material, online

evaluation, comparison' were found fairly satisfactory and in most of the cases appreciable.

However, the category of 'network' was found relatively wanting and needs more stability,

which the meeting opined that was a regional and University level infrastructural issue.

Action Taken

The meeting proposed and initiated measures to improve the quality and outcome of the online

teaching. It has taken the following action in this regard:

• Regarding the category of 'network', it has decided to increase the number of online

classes/effective teaching hours in order to overcome the infrastructural gap that the

students face

• It has decided to increase the volume of 'materials' shared as 'notes' and reading

materials like 'e-books' etc.

• It has also decided to include multiple platforms like the Google Meet, Zoom, WhatsApp

and YouTube Presentations in order to increase the shortages in 'interaction'.

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
