Progress Seminar proposals of the following scholars are discussed :


(A) Ruman Sutradhar & Sunita Das were admitted to the Ph.D. programme of the department in the year 2016 under old rules and they were provisionally registered under no. Ph.D./3103/17 dtd. 31/03/2017 & no. Ph.D./3104/17 dtd. 31/03/2017 respectively. But due to some confusion arising out of the introduction of new rules, the department considered them as Ph.D. scholar to be guided by new rules and accordingly the Research Advisory Committee(s) were formed and they were also asking to present their 6 (six) monthly Progress Report before the Research Advisory Committee. But of late it has come to the notice that they should have been guided by old rules and should have applied for the Final Registration. Considering the fact that the candidates were not at fault, it was unanimously resolved that the 6 (six) monthly progress report of the scholars be considered as the Final Registration seminar and their application for Final Registration be considered even though they have crossed 18 months time limit after the provisional Registration as prescribed in the old rules. It was also resolved that the cases be referred to the School Board for sympathetic consideration.

(B) Ruchira Gupta an M.Phil scholar under Registration no. M.Phil/1101/17 dtd. 31/03/2017 applied for extension of time for the submission of M.Phil dissertation beyond the maximum duration 4 (four) semesters as stipulated in the old rules.
