Regulations on permission/affiliation of MA/M.Sc/M.Com or other Post Graduate Courses in Affiliated Colleges:

[General conditions to start Post Graduate (PG) courses in an Affiliated College]

- (1) For introduction of PG Course in a college it should be seen that there exists proper infrastructure, adequate number of qualified teachers and a well-equipped Library.
- (2) In case of a provincialised college, the college should have a clearance from the concerned Department at the State Government for opening PG Department in the college. For Govt. College, the corresponding rule as applicable will be followed.
- (3) The college should see that a separate set of teachers are made available for teaching PG courses in the colleges, without disturbing the normal classes of the existing undergraduate courses being run in the colleges by the existing teachers.
- (4) No affiliated college shall be allowed to start a PG course in any subject without prior permission of the university.
- (5) No student shall be admitted to any PG class in any affiliated college before permission to start the classes is granted by the university. Breach of this rule may be sufficient ground for refusal of permission.
- (6) No affiliated college shall be eligible to start PG courses in any subject, unless the college has been affiliated for teaching the subject concerned up-to Honours standard for not less than ten years prior to the year of application for permission to start PG classes in that subject,
- (7) No affiliated college shall be allowed to start PG classes in more than three subjects in a year. These three subjects are to be chosen in keeping with the provisions for offering 'Open Paper' as stipulated under CBCS guidelines of UGC.

First Application:

- (8) When an affiliated college proposes to start PG courses in any subject, the Principal shall submit an application to the Director, College Development Council in triplicate with the prescribed fees, which is not refundable under any circumstances.

The application should, inter alia, contain the following particulars:-

- i) Period for which there has been provision and affiliation for teaching up to honours standard in the subject or subjects proposed to be taught up to PG standard.
- ii) Number of students admitted to the Hons. Courses subject wise and year-wise for preceding ten years for the proposed subjects
