

ssam University, Silchar (A Central University) was established by an Act of Parliament promulgated in 1989 (Act XIII) and enforced by a Notification of the Government of India in January 1994. In 2008 the University has been accredited by NAAC with Grade B with CGPA of 2.85.

The campus, situated in Dargakona, about 20 kms from Silchar is set amid sprawling hillocks, a typical landscape in North East. The campus in an area of 600 acres surrounded by lakes and mountains provides an ideal environment for educational pursuit.

Drawing its 230 plus faculty from many disciplines, from all over the


country, the University sustains a multidisciplinary approach to higher education.

his Department started its journey in July 1997. Since its inception, it is producing capable people who are committed to work in social sector and are passionate to make a difference in the world in which they live.


The Department holds the pride of place being pioneer in the field of



The Department runs Five Year Integrated course in Social Work which leads to BSW (three years) and MSW (two years) Degrees. The Master Degree course curriculum offers opportunities for specialization in Disaster Management, Human Rights and Advocacy, NGO Management, Micro-Finance and Livelihood, Urban development, Rural Development, Family and Child Welfare, Medical and Psychiatric Social Work etc.

The Department also offers Ph.D. programme. The thrust of the current research endeavors in the Department is on the areas like Health, AIDS, ICDS Scheme, Panchayati Raj, NGOs, and Corporate Voluntarism etc. The Faculty members have also been taking up various research projects apart from imparting education





Development of a perspective for various social problems, issues and their solutions, development of professional skills in solving problems and integration in class room teaching with practice of Social Work are the objective of field work.

Goal oriented, planned and supervised field work is integral part of BSW MSW programs. During the 5 years, field work is intended to expose the students to a multi vitiate environment and exposure to working with individuals, groups and communities. It includes observation visit, concurrent field work in different agencies & communities and Block Placement. The students are given appropriate field work orientation by the faculty member of the department. Students are given input of both theory and practical knowledge through regular individual conferences and group conferences with the faculty members.

Observation Visit

After joining the bachelor programme in the department, the students are exposed to different social service organization, each includes government departments, NGOs/VOs, autonomous agencies, industries etc. This helps the students to get an overview of the functioning of various organizations and to understand the scope of professional Social Work in their future field work.

Concurrent Field Work


Objectives:
