Department of Social Work



About the University



Assam University, Silchar was established in 1994 as a Central University by an Act of Parliament (Act 13 of 1989) enforced through notification of the Government of India.

The University over the years has made impressive strides in establishing itself as a premier institution of learning in Northeast India where the emphasis persistently has been on blending quality education, socially relevant endeavours and scientific pursuits with mission-orientation and tireless striving for excellence.

The sprawling University Campus is spread over an area of about 600 areas where 29 Post-Graduate Departments under nine Schools of studies of the University function. The Institution provides state of the art facilities to students who come from different parts of the county and abroad. The current role strength is above 3000 which includes the students at the Post-Graduate and Integrated Courses and the students and the researchers at MPhil and PhD levels.

The Campus is at a distance of 23 kilometers From Silchar town. Silchar being the gate way to the southern part of North-East India is the hub commercial activities and is known for its history as the Tea Capital South Assam. Away from the humdrum of the busy city life o Silchar and set amidst its sylvan surroundings, the University community engages itself in academic pursuits.

With the mystique Bhuvan and the Barail ranges of hills at the backdrop, Assam University Campus is surrounded by the lush green hill locks, natural lakes and picturesque tea gardens of South Assam. The serene setting together with exquisite natural beauty in and around the campus adds uniqueness to the University's ambience capturing viewers' imagination and provides an ideal atmosphere for study and research.

About the Department



In Assam University, the Department of Social Work is one of the six departments of the school of social Sciences. It started its journey in July, 1997 with only two faculty members. Since then the department has grown in its strength and activity across the region. The department of Social Work is the only institute of north east India to have a five years integrated course in Social Work and offers multivariate field exposures and specialization to its student. At present there are fourteen teachers with various specialization of Social Work. The aim is to prepare Social Work professional through practice and research based teaching to respond to social change, welfare and developmental needs at various levels.

The department runs Five Years Integrated Course in Social Work which leads to BSW (Three Years) and MSW (Two years). This year the department is running several specializations at Master's Degree level namely Disaster Management, Human Rights, NGO Management and Rural Development.

Regarding research, the department is offering Ph.D. Programme. Scholars have been perusing Ph.D. in the area of Health Care, HIV/AIDS, Self Help Group, Panchayat Raj, Government of India partnership, Unorganized Labour, Corporate Volunteerism etc. Apart from teaching, the faculty members have also been taking up minor as well as major research projects.

The Domain of Field Practice

Development of a perspective for various social problems, issues and their solutions, development of professional skills in solving problems and integration in class room teaching with practice of Social Work are the objective of field work.

Goal oriented, planned and supervised fieldwork is integral part of BSW and MSW programs. During the five years, field work is intended to expose the students to a multi vitiate environment and exposure to working with individuals, groups and communities. It includes Observation Visit, Concurrent field work in different agencies and communities and Block Placement. The students are given appropriate fieldwork orientation by the facuity members of the depurtment. Students are given input of both theory and practical knowledge through regular individual conferences and group conferences with the faculty members.

Observation Fisit :

After joining the bachelor programme in the department, the students are exposed to different social service organization, each includes government departments, NGOs/VOs, autonomous agencies, industries etc. This helps the students to get an overview of the functioning of various organizations and to understand the scope of professional Social Work and thus aid in their future field work.

Concurrent Field Work

 To provide students with an opportunity to apply theories in practice for problem solving with individuals, groups and communities.
