The domain of Field Practice

Development of a perspective for various social problems, issues, and their solutions, development of professional skills in solving problems,

Inputs on both theory & practical are provided through regular Individual & Group Conferences are provided by the faculty members.

OBJECTIVES

- Understanding of socio-economic, cultural, and political milieu and development of the capacity for critical examination among students
- Integration of classroom teaching with field practice
- Goal-Oriented planned and supervised fieldwork to expose the students to a multi-vitiate environment and to work with individuals, groups, and communities
- To help students appreciate the role of the Social Work profession in empowering individuals, groups & communities and facilitate social change.

FIELD WORK INCLUDES

- Observation Visit After enrollment into the course students are exposed to different social service organizations (Govt, NGOs/VOs, autonomous agencies, industries, etc). This helps the students to get an overview of the functioning of various organizations and to understand the scope of professional Social Work and thus aid in their future fieldwork.
- Block Placement After completion of five semesters, students are sent for block placement for 45 days in various agencies suiting their area of interest & expertise.
- Concurrent placement Students get placement for one year in any community/ NGOs/ GOs from 2nd year onwards.




