**B. Pharm. entrance examination:** Venue & time shall be intimated by HoD, Pharmaceutical Science separately.

**Note:**

1. It may so happen that some candidates may apply in two different departments. The exam of both such departments may be scheduled in session 1 in any of the entrance days.

In such case the candidate may appear in the exam in Session 1 in any department of his/her choice. Steps are to be taken, by the Departmental Admission Committee to collect question papers for the entrance exam from the other department where the applicant has also applied. Such applicants shall not be allowed to leave the examination hall at 12 but shall be supplied with the question paper/answer script at the same hall at 12 noon. Necessary announcement in this regard may be made at the beginning of Session 1. After termination of the **repeat exam of Session 1** the answer scripts may kindly be send to the concerned department for evaluation.

2. It may so happen that some candidates may apply in two different departments. The exam of both such departments may be scheduled in session 2.

In such case the candidate may appear in the exam in Session 2 in any department of his/her choice. Steps are to be taken, by the Departmental Admission Committee to collect question papers for the entrance exam from the other department where the applicant has also applied. Such applicants shall not be allowed to leave the examination hall at 3 pm but shall be supplied with the question paper/answer script at the same hall at 3 pm. Necessary announcement in this regard may be made at the beginning of Session 2. After termination of the **repeat exam of Session 2** the answer scripts may kindly be send to the concerned department for evaluation.

**3. Computation of composite score:**

- (i) Suppose a student has applied in a department "X" for a PG course. He/she has graduated from Assam University or any institution affiliated to Assam University. He or she has secured 76% marks in honours in the same subject "X". Then his/her marks in qualifying examination shall be:

$$\begin{array}{ccccccc} & & \boxed{\begin{array}{l} \text{Increment due to} \\ \text{honours in same} \\ \text{subject i.e. 10\% of} \\ \text{secured marks (76)} \\ = 7.6 \end{array}} & + & \boxed{\begin{array}{l} \text{Increment due to} \\ \text{his/her affiliation to} \\ \text{Assam University} \\ \text{i.e. 30\% of secured} \\ \text{marks (76)} = 22.8 \end{array}} & & = 76 + 7.6 + 22.8 = 106.4 \\ 76 + & & & & & & \\ \downarrow & & \swarrow & & \swarrow & & \swarrow \\ \text{(A)} + & & \text{(B)} & + & \text{(C)} & = & \text{(D)} \end{array}$$

**Please note:**

- In case the student does not have Honours in the subject X but is affiliated to Assam University he will not get any benefit from (B) but only from (C)

- In case the student is not affiliated to Assam University but has honours in the subject X then he will not get any benefit from (C) but only from (B)
  - In case the student is neither affiliated to Assam University nor has honours in the subject X then he will not get any benefit from (B) and (C)
- (iii) Suppose the student got 32 out of 50 in the written test and 18 out of 25 in personal interview.
- (iv) Then the formula for computing the composite score, providing weightage of 25 to Qualifying Examination, 50 to Written Test and 25 to Personal Interview is,

$$25 \times \left( \frac{(D)}{100} \right) + 50 \times \left( \frac{\text{Marks obtained in written test}}{\text{Total marks in written test}} \right) + 25 \times \left( \frac{\text{Marks obtained in interview}}{\text{Total marks in interview}} \right)$$

**(For this example: it shall be)**

$$= 25 \times \left( \frac{106.4}{100} \right) + 50 \times \left( \frac{32}{50} \right) + 25 \times \left( \frac{18}{25} \right) = 76.6$$

where, (D) is the percentage of marks secured by the candidate in the qualifying examination after increment, if applicable due to honours and/or Assam University affiliation as shown in the example in 3(i) above. For that example (D) = 106.4

#### **4. Personal Interview**

The viva or personal interview shall be conducted in the respective department by the Departmental Admission Committee (DAC) within the dates 7 to 11 July, 2017 in the respective department. The date and time of which shall be notified by the concerned departments in the University Web site and in the departmental notice boards well in advance.

#### **5. Uploading of Composite Score**

The composite score thus computed shall be uploaded in the website through the HOD's portal in the university's website dedicated for admission.

#### **6. Suspension of Classes**

All the classes of other semesters viz. third, fifth etc. shall remain suspended on 7.7.2017, 8.7.2017 & 10.7.2017 so the upcoming entrance examination can be smoothly conducted.
