The Chairman welcomed all the members to the ^{Seventh} ~~sixth~~ meeting of Departmental Affairs Committee of the Department of Statistics, Assam University.

The agenda of the discussion circulated before the meeting. The discussions were held on all the agenda. After thread bearing discussion the following resolutions were taken.

Agenda: Decision about the modalities of evaluation of Paper No-405

Resolution: The meeting resolved that the process of evaluation of paper no. 405 (Project Paper) for M.A/M.Sc (Statistics) shall be undertaken in the following manner:

- (1) The external examiner shall evaluate each presenter for a total of 40 marks, with a break up of 20 + 20.
 - 20 marks shall be for the presentation of the project, which shall be in power point.
 - The remaining 20 marks shall be for report writing, i.e., the report submitted by the student in the department in duplicate.
- (2) The supervisor of the project shall evaluate the candidate for a total of 35 marks, out of which 5 marks shall be for timely submission. Depending on the continuous performance of the candidate while undergoing the project, the supervisor shall award marks out of the remaining 30.
- (3) The other teachers of the department (teachers except the Supervisor) shall also evaluate the candidate. The evaluation shall be for a maximum of 25 marks. The evaluation shall be based on the "Progress Presentation" conducted earlier in the department for evaluating the progress of the candidate in the project. For a given candidate the average of the marks, awarded by the other faculty members out of 25, shall be considered.


(4) The sum of these three factors,

- (i) Marks awarded by external examiner out of 40
- (ii) Marks awarded by Supervisor out of 35
- (iii) Average of marks awarded by other teachers out of 25

shall be the total marks awarded to a student in the paper 405.

However, no student shall be allowed to present unless he/she submits the project report in written form.
