

NATIONAL STATISTICS DAY CELEBRATION

29TH JUNE, 2020

The Department of Statistics, Assam University celebrated the National Statistics Day 2020 on 29th June, 2020, the birth anniversary of Prof. P.C. Mahalanobis who was the doyen of Statistics education in India. The coordinator of the program was Dr. Rama Shanker, Associate Professor, Department of Statistics, Assam University, Silchar. To commemorate the event the Department organized a one day Webinar on “Life and contributions of Prof. Mahalanobis and Applications of Statistics”. All students, research scholars and faculties of Department of Statistics, Assam University and other colleges/universities joined the first ever online-program of the Department through Cisco Webex from 3 P.M to 6 P.M on 29th June, 2020.

The event started at 3.00 P.M with a welcome address by the Head of the Department of Statistics, Prof. Dibyojyoti Bhattacharjee. After welcoming all the participants of the national Statistics day he discussed in details about the importance of National Statistics Day and how to use statistical knowledge and statistical thinking for making the world a better place.

The Dean of the Albert Einstein School of Physical Sciences Prof. C R Bhattacharjee, delivered a brief but relevant speech on the event and discussed the importance of Statistics in different fields of knowledge.

The honorable Vice Chancellor of the university, Prof. D. C. Nath discussed the history of National Statistics Day, its importance and laid stress on how to develop the undergraduate and graduate courses of Statistics and improve the quality of research in Statistics so as to solve societal problems. Further, he opined that statistics should play a major role in solving problems of real life and to contribute towards the development of the nation.
