Report of the Five Day Workshop on Data Analysis in SPSS

25th February to 1st March, 2019

As a part of the different training programmes organized by the Department, a Workshop was planned from 25th February to 1st March, 2019. As the demand of conducting training programs in Statistical Packages of Social Science (SPSS) was always their from the Research Scholars and faculty members of the other departments so this workshop was designed. This was the time when the university was busy with the celebration of Social Week and the regular PG classes of the university was suspended. This provided with the opportunity to organize the event without disturbing the regular academic activities of the department. Most teachers at that time were in leave so the event was organized by the research scholars of the department viz. Mr. Mrinal Deka and Ms. Priyanka Talukdar. The Head of the Department, Prof. Dibyojyoti Bhattacharjee was the sole resource person in the entire workshop.

The expenses of running the workshop was from the Registration Fees of the participants. The university also contributed some money from the Annual Course Fees of the Department. The target participants for the workshop was PG Students, Registered/enrolled Ph.D or M. Phil student anmd Faculty Member of any recognized university/college/institute who is in need of training in SPSS. It is pertinent to mention here that the department possesses licensed version of SPSS 23.0.

The main objective of the workshop was to train the participants on Data Analysis using SPSS along with the underlying theory behind different statistical tools. It will comprise the lectures on basic statistics and basics of SPSS, descriptive statistics and graphs in SPSS, bivariate data analysis, multiple regression, parametric and non-parametric tests, factor analysis, cluster analysis, discriminant analysis, survival analysis, logistic regression, time series analysis and scaling techniques in SPSS with a brief outline of relevant theory.

A total of 44 participants registered for the workshop out of which 7 of them were out-station participants. Participants were from different disciplines viz. Library Science, Management, Mathematics, Life Science, Doctors, Economics, Political Science, Commerce, Statistics, Social Work, Education etc. The detailed participants list are as follows:
