REPORT OF THE NATIONAL STATISTICS DAY CELEBRATION 2021

The Department of Statistics, Assam University celebrated the National Statistics Day 2021 on 29th June 2021, the birth anniversary of Prof. P.C. Mahalanobis, the doyen of Statistics education in India. The program coordinator was Dr. Vivek Verma, Assistant Professor, Department of Statistics, Assam University, Silchar. All students, research scholars, and faculties of the Department of Statistics, Assam University, and other colleges/universities joined this online program of the Department through the Google meet link (https://meet.google.com/hgsdbkc-ytn) from 4 P.M to 6 P.M on 29th June 2021. The event started at 4.00 P.M with a welcome address by the Head of the Department of Statistics, Dr. Rama Shankar. After welcoming all the participants of the National Statistics Day, he discussed the life and contributions, and leadership qualities of Prof P.C. Mahalanobis, which identified him as a Statistician, a great philosopher and inspiration for everyone. The Dean of the Albert Einstein School of Physical Sciences, Professor C R Bhattacharjee, delivered a brief but very informative speech on the importance of Statistics and its relevance in different fields of knowledge. The Honorable Vice-Chancellor of the university, Prof. Dilip Chandra Nath, shared very insightful thoughts on the contribution and journey of Prof P.C. Mahalanobis in Statistics and emphasized the current role of statistics and statisticians in the Covid-19 pandemic situation.

The gracious presence of two eminent speakers' Prof Sada Nand Dwivedi, Senior most Professor of Biostatistics AIIMS, New Delhi, and Dr. Sandip Mitra, Professor of Sampling and Official Statistics Unit, ISI Kolkata, made the celebration memorable. Dr. Sandip Mitra, in his presentation, the fundamental concepts on the topic "Community-Level Data: Current Relevance and Future Challenges", where he discussed insightful overviews and role of Prof P C Mahalanobis in Community-Level Data collection and its related prospects in research and its significance in Sustainable Development Goals. Prof Sada Nand Dwivedi enlightened through a "Multilevel Models: Community Impact on Public Health." He educated through his speech on the role and contribution of PC Mahalanobis in Multilevel Models and their applications in various disciplines. Also, he highlighted real applications that will help statisticians and young scientists justify the significance of Statistics in practical situations.


The Department also organized an online quiz contest too on that day on the theme "Life and contributions of Prof. Mahalanobis and Applications of Statistics," coordinated by Prof.
