The Chairman welcomed all the members to the Thirty-seventh meeting of the Departmental Affairs Committee (DAC) of the Department of Statistics, Assam University.

The agenda of the discussion was circulated before the meeting. The discussions were held as per the agenda items. After discussion the following resolutions were taken.

# Agenda1: Workshop on Data Science Resolution:

The agenda of conducting a workshop on Data Science was discussed. Prof. Dibyojyoti Bhattacharjee proposed to conduct a "Faculty Development Programme on Data Analytics and Decision Making" from 21-25 November, 2022 in collaboration with Statistical Quality Control Unit of Indian Statistical Institute (ISI), Kolkata. The primarily discussion of which was materialized in the recent educational tour of the department in ISI.

It was further decided that (i) an amount of Rs. 50,000/- shall be asked from the University for conducting the programme.

(ii) An additional amount of Rs. 30,000/- will be spent from the Course fee for organizing the programme. SQC Unit of ISI, Kolkata is eager to collaborate in the FDP. They will be bearing travelling and living expenses of 3 Resource persons for 3 days (from ISI, Kolkata).

Other expenses will be borne from the Registration fees of the participants and from the amount collected from (i) and (ii) above. 40 participants will be allowed to participate in the FDP. Prof. Dibyojyoti Bhattacharjee shall act as the coordinator of the event. Approval of the competent authority shall be sought in this regard.

# Agenda 2: Computer Lab facility and its expansion Resolution:

Considering the increase in the number of students over the years it was decided to add 20 more computers in the computer laboratory of the department. Necessary computer tables and chairs are also required which shall be purchased from the course fee. The competent authority may be approached for procurement of the 20 computers, as the course fee of the department is very meger.

# Agenda 3: Second Semester classes and Exam Resolution:

It was decided that the second semester classes may be started from 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 onwards.

#### **Resolution:**

It was decided to spend Rs. 30,000/- for FDP. 5 revolving chairs to be purchased, 2 external hard disk, 10 computer tables and chair and 20 antiviruses for the department purpose from Course Fees.
