**RES/CSE/DAC/2018-08/ITEM-03a:**

Prof Sudipta Roy raised the matter related to the communication made by UGC and AICTE for installing sanitary napkin vending machines and incinerators in the academic institutes to facilitate the girl students of the department. All the members have appreciated and agreed to the proposal. It was unanimously resolved that the department may initiate the purchase and installation of vending machine and incinerator as per the communication received from UGC/AICTE. The total cost involved is Rs 71095.45, which may be provided from the annual course fees fund of the department. 
