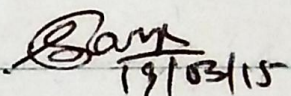
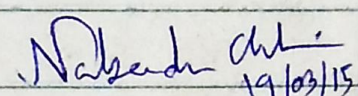
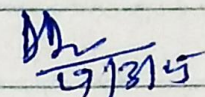
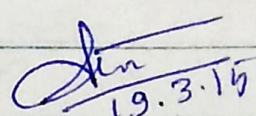
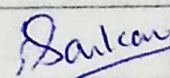
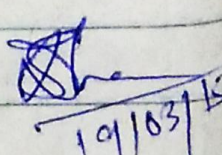


A joint meeting of 14th BUGS & 10th BPGS was held on 19th March, 2015 at # 11:30 AM at the Seminar room of department of Information Technology.

After threadbare discussions the following resolutions were adopted unanimously.

Agenda : TSSOT/BPGS-IT/10:01: Confirmation of the minute of 13th BUGS and 9th BPGS in IT

Resolution: TSSOT/BPGS-IT/10:01: As there is observations of the members, the minute of the 13th BUGS and 9th BPGS is confirmed.

Agenda : TSSOT/BPGS-IT/10:02: New proposed CBCS

Resolution. TSSOT/BPGS-IT/10:02: The Chairman apprised the members about the new proposed CBCS format and documents circulated by UGC and the University. After threadbare discussion, the following resolutions are made.

The members also opined that there is no available guideline from AICTE about the matter and as soon as the guideline of AICTE is available, the department will prepare the framework by organising a workshop to adopt the guideline in the school level. Though, in principle the members resolved the following:

TSSOT/BPGS-IT/10:02.01: The students from one department can earn credits from other departments within the school. The permissible limit of credits will be decided in the workshop.

TSSOT/BPGS-IT/10:02.02: The open courses will be offered in semester VII in B.Tech and semester II in MTech programmes respectively.

TSSOT/BPGS-IT/10:02.03: The distribution of the internal and external marks will be decided in the workshop only.

Agenda : TSSOT/BPGS-IT/10:03: New Academic Calender

Resolution. TSSOT/BPGS-IT/10:03: The Chairman apprised the members about the new Academic calender proposed for the department of IT.

The Chairman proposed that the end semester answer scripts after evaluation may be shown to the students for their betterment. The students will be informed about their weaknesses so that they may not make the same mistake in future. After the completion of the student-viewing of the answer scripts, the examiners will submit the papers as per practice. After in-depth discussion, the members agreed in principle and forwarded to the School Board for discussion and consideration as this should be a common practice for the school.

Agenda: TSSOT/BPGS-IT/Admission/10:08: Eligibility criteria of M.Tech (IT) programme

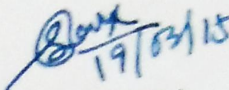
Resolution: TSSOT/BPGS-IT/Admission/10:08: The Chairman appraised the members about the existing eligibility criteria of M.Tech (IT) programme. Considering the present scenario and the eligibility criteria of other universities, the members modified the eligibility criteria as below:

The students are eligible for M.Tech(IT) who have secured 60% marks in aggregate throughout their carrier and have qualified

- (i) B.E./B. Tech in IT/CSE/Electronics/Electrical Engg. or equivalent branches or equivalent degrees
- (ii) M.Sc. in CS/Electronics/IT/Maths/Physics or equivalent or
- (iii) MCA

The admission process will consist of written test and personal interview. The syllabus of the written test will be the GATE syllabus of CSE/IT. The GATE (CS/IT) qualified students will be given 70% weightage as per AICTE norms. The eligibility criteria and the admission procedure may be implemented from the academic session 2015-16.

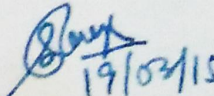
