The members confirmed the minutes of the last i.e. Departmental Affairs Committeemeeting.

RES/CSE/DAC/2021-o4/ITEM-02:

Resolution: Order No: 139/AU - TSSOT/CIRCULAR- NOT/2021, dated 12th April 2021

The Chairperson appraised the members regarding receipt of an Office order from the O/O the Dean TSSOT, regarding deputation of Sri Asit Das, skilled worker in collection and despatch of various daks to and from all the departments of TSSOT including the O/O Dean. TSSOT vide Order NO. 139/AU - TSSOT/CIRCULAR- NOT/2021, dated 12th April 2021. In this regard after threadbare discussion of the matter at hand the members present unanimously resolved that, releasing Sri Asit Das, skilled worker from the department of CSE, may not be

possible at present. This is due to the fact that, during the continued period of COVID 19, office work of the department as well as the load per faculty has increased many folds due to online mode of taking classes, examinations, compiling various data against UGC notifications, dean office, Assam University administrative orders etc. Also,the members pressed upon the ensuing NAAC visit which is scheduled on $06^{th} - 08^{th}$ May 2021. The members also have stressed upon the fact that, department of CSE is running with acute shortage of manpower as

compared to its sister department viz. Agricultural Engineering, which hosts a number of permanent/contractual non-teaching staffs, and have suggested requisition of manpower from Agricultural Engineering for the purpose against the said Dean Office order. The members, through this resolution, have also requested the O/O Dean TSSOT, to spare a willing eye for arranging man power to manage various Laboratories, libraries etc. of the Department of CSE.

RES/CSE/DAC/2021-4/ITEM-03:

Resolution: Replacement for Mr. Navajyoti Nath, STA, Department of CSE.

As it is may be known, Sri Navajyoti Nath has joined as Assistant Registrar, Assam University leaving the post of STA from the department of CSE, the members suggested a replacement for him in the Department for looking after the day to day work of Sri Nath. In this regard as of now the Department of CSE does not have any lien order or resignation letter of Sri Navajyoti Nath against the post in which he has joined. So the department is understaff in regard to technical staffs as well as requires suitable replacement(s).

RES/CSE/DAC/2021-0\/ITEM-04:

The Chairperson appraised the members regarding receipt of an Office Letter from the O/O the Dean TSSOT for forming various school level committees vide Letter No: 139/AU – TSSOT/CIRCULAR – NOT/2021/181-88 dated 13th April 2021. After thread bare discussion the members resolved that

- 1. For committees such as Prospectus preparation, Admission, CUCET, Accreditation, Research promotion and Training & Placement, a wider school level discussion is required with all the stakeholders and hence, Dean TSSOT is requested to convene a School Level meeting with all the stakeholders to discuss the matter at length.
- 2. For the examination committee, the department is of the opinion that, convening and managing examination at the department level is much more prudent as it is practiced in the other Schools of the University. Also, by managing examination at the department level may avoid complication as those have been faced in the End Semester Examination of December 2018, in the history of TSSOT. Therefore, members resolved that, the Examination of the Department of CSE shall be taken care by the department itself and therefore department shall not propose any name for the School examination committee.

After discussion members have decided to organize the 4th International Conference on Computational Intelligence in Communications, and Business Analytics (CICBA 2021)" CICBA 2021" in the 1st week of December, 2021 (2nd-3rdDecember tentatively) in offline / blended mode in the department of Computer Science & Engineering.
