## RES/CSE/DAC/2021-09 /ITEM-01:

The members confirmed the minutes of the last Departmental Affairs Committee meeting.

## RES/CSE/DAC/2021-09 /ITEM-02:

Members have discussed about the preparation of NAAC Peer Team visit during 15-17th September 2021.In this connection department has decided to carry on some of the essential works attached as annexure A. To execute the works an estimated budget of Rs 300,000 lakhs is proposed from the Course fee fund of CSE. The members have unanimously agreed to the budget and decided that the proposed amount of Rs 300,000 may be taken as advance in the name of Dr. Mousum Handique, IQAC Coordinator so that work can be completed as early as possible.

The Chairperson placed before the members the feedback report of online teaching 2021 and after threadbare discussion resolutions were taken and attached as annexure B.

#### RES/CSE/DAC/2021-09 /ITEM-04:

All members discussed the course allocation of B.Tech and M.Tech Odd Semester 2021 and finalized the distribution of different course among the faculty members in the department of CSE, TSSOT, Assam University. The details of course distribution is given in Annexure C.

#### RES/CSE/DAC/2021-09 /ITEM-05:

The members have discussed about the starting of Post Graduate Diploma Course in collaboration with CDAC in the department. After discussion members decided to have a separate meeting for this purpose.

#### RES/CSE/DAC/2021-09 /ITEM-06:

(a) It is discussed that the department of Computer Science & Engineering in association with Department of Social Work will organize one extension programme "Awareness cum Distribution



programme: COVID-19" Pandemic , Silchar during September 2021. The coordinator of the event will be Dr. Sunita Sarkar and Dr. Somnath Mukhopadhyay and Prof. M. Tineshwari Devi. An estimated budget of Rs. 35,000/- is placed as for conducting the extension programme.

- (b) It is discussed that the department of Computer Science & Engineering will organize one workshop on Emerging Technologies of Quantum Computing during the month of November 2021. The coordinator of the event will be Dr. Mousum Handique. An estimated budget of Rs. 300,000/- is placed for conducting the programme.
