At the outset, the Chairman welcomed all the Members. On being permitted by the Chairman, the meeting formally started.

(A) Agenda item for confirmation:

Item No. 1: Confirmation of the minutes of the 119th, 120th & 121st Meeting of EC:

Item No. 2: Confirmation of the minutes of the 122nd Meeting(Spl) of EC

EC:123:11-18:01: The minutes of the 119th, 120th (Special) & 121st (Emergent) Meeting of the Executive Council held on 5th June 2018, 27th June 2018 and 12th July 2018 respectively were placed before the Council for consideration and confirmation along with the Actions taken report of the above meetings.

Resolution: While going through the minutes of the meetings as mentioned above and perusal of Action Taken Report, the members felt it appropriate to consider the item for Confirmation of the Minutes of 122nd Meeting (Special) together. And hence, item No. 1 and item No. 2 of the agenda are clubbed and the Council approved both the items under Confirmation of Minutes along with the Action Taking Reports.

Further, while considering the minutes of the 122nd adjourned meeting (Special) of the Executive Council held on 19th November, 2018 in respect to item No. 1 related to ICC case of Dr. Sudipta Sarkar, two of the regular members namely, Prof. Sajal Nag and Prof. Sudipto Roy were in the opinion that the action of the University Administration was not appropriate as per rule for the matter and they expressed their reservation in the form of 'Note of Dissent' which was placed before the Chairman as, " i)The reports of ICC and administrative scrutiny relating to the alleged harassment of Dr. Sudipto Sarkar were not provided or placed despite several requests to the authority and the discussion was made in the absence of reports. ii) The suspension of Dr. Sudipto Sarkar could be extended only before the expiry of 90 days from the date of suspension and cannot be extended now as this has no legal sanction."

On being heard the members and consideration of related pros and cons, the Council was in the opinion that the Report placed in the 122nd Meeting of the EC needs further clarification; and therefore, the Council resolved to refer back the existing ICC Report to the ICC again for a specific and clear recommendation within 15 days from the date of issue of the letter to the ICC and till an administrative decision is taken, the suspension in respect of Dr. Sarkar shall continue.

The item was placed before the Council for ratification.



Item No. 8 : Counting of past service of Dr. Purnendu Das, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science.



Item No. 16 : Abolition of affidavits and promotion of Self-Certification - reg:

EC:123:11-18:16: The MHRD vide letter No. F.No. 19-16/2014-Desk U(Pt) dtd. 10th August 2015 and subsequent letters of even no. dtd. 4th June 2018 & 19th August 2018 requested Vice Chancellor's of all Central Universities to accept the self attested copies from the applicants for admission, and the original certificates should be called only from the finally selected candidates. Similarly the University is requested not to ask for any affidavits from the applicants except those cases where affidavits are required under law. In view of this the Examination department, Assam University has proposed to abolish the practice of seeking affidavits for issuing Duplicate Marksheets, Certificates and such other documents from the applicants with immediate effect and system of Self-Certification be introduced. This proposal has been vetted by our Internal Legal Consultant and accordingly the same has been approved by the Vice Chancellor.


