## **Instructions For C.RET Test**

## **Department of Political Science**

Kindly go through the following instructions carefully this shall help you in performing in the upcoming C-RET examination for entry into the M. Phil/Ph. D program.

- 1. The C-RET Admission Test will be conducted online on 17<sup>th</sup> August between10.00 to 11:00 A.M.
- 2. The online test will be conducted using Google form. The link of the test shall be e-mailed to you few minutes prior to the start of the test.
- 3. In the first section of the question you are to provide your personal details like name, email id and application number. The application number is available in your admit card and in case of email id you are to use the same id that was used by you in the application form.
- 4. The test will be of 50 marks consisting of 25 compulsory multiple choice questions each of one marks and also 25 marks subjective questions. The subjective questions are to be answered in the space provided below the questions in the Google form within the word limits provided..
- 5. The pass marks for the written test is 25 out of 50. However, relaxation of 5 percent is given to those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/Differently abled
- 6. The results of the written test will be notified by the afternoon of 17<sup>th</sup>August, 2020 by email and also be sent for uploading in the website.
- 7. Candidates who score 25 or more out of 50 in the written test shall only be considered for the Viva/personal interview. However, there shall be a relaxation of 5% of marks for applicants belonging to SC/ST/OBC (NCL)//Differently-abled categories.
- 8. On 17<sup>th</sup>August, 2020 evening the time for Viva/Personal Interview shall be notified to the selected candidates by email. Each candidate shall be interviewed by Google meet and should have to make one presentation on their area of research interest
- 9. Please note- all communication/instructions to the candidates related to the entrance test shall be made through email. The candidates are advised to check their emails regularly.
- 10. Candidates can appear either for M.Phil or for Ph.D. So, candidates who applied for both options should forefeit one.
- 11. To appear in the C.RET, 2020 which is scheduled on August 17, 2020 at 10.00 A.M, OBC candidates are required to submit valid Non Creamy Layer (NCL) Certificate by August 14 (Friday), 2020. In case, the valid NCL certificate is not received within the deadline mentioned above your candidature will stand cancelled and you will be barred from appearing in the C.RET Test.
