



# ASSAM UNIVERSITY: SILCHAR

## NOTIFICATION

On the recommendation of University Admission Committee, 2021 and as approved by the Vice Chancellor, it is notified that the following guidelines will be followed for Admission to PG Courses 2021 (both Silchar & Diphu Campus).

- The following schedule will be implemented during the course of PG admission-2021.

a.	Approval of applications by the Department	Up to 23 <sup>rd</sup> Nov. 2021
b.	On-line Entrance Test	25 <sup>th</sup> Nov. to 5 <sup>th</sup> Dec. 2021
c.	Publication of First list	7 <sup>th</sup> December, 2021
d.	Payment of Fees for First list candidates	7 <sup>th</sup> - 8 <sup>th</sup> December, 2021
e.	Publication of Second list	11 <sup>th</sup> December, 2021
f.	Payment of Fees for Second list candidates	11 <sup>th</sup> -13 <sup>th</sup> December, 2021
g.	Commencement of 1 <sup>st</sup> Semester classes	10 <sup>th</sup> December, 2021

- The Department shall approve the application forms pending the TDC end semester marks, if any.
- The entrance test shall be conducted using the Assam University Online Examination Portal. The test will have the provision for both the components, i.e. Online Test & PI. It is up to the Departments to conduct both i.e. the Online test & PI or only the Online test. The schedule for Online Admission Test is furnished at Annexure - A
- For Online test MCQ type questions with four alternatives shall be mandatory.
- The Online test shall be of one-hour duration having maximum marks 50.
- In case of both, i.e. Online test & PI, the maximum marks 50 will be distributed in the ratio 4:1, i.e. 40 marks to Online test & 10 marks to PI.
- Applicants claiming reservation benefit need to submit their Caste Certificate released by the Govt. of India. Those belonging to OBC category must submit valid Non-creamy Layer Certificate as per the Govt. of India format. Those applying under Economically Weaker Section (EWS) category must submit Income & Asset Certificate issued by the appropriate authority in the prescribed format of the GOI.
- Applicants completing their graduation from colleges / institutes affiliated to Assam University will get an additional weightage equivalent to 30% of their Entrance Test (Online Test + PI, if any) score.
- Candidates seeking admission into P.G. program with Honours/Major subjects at Under Graduate level will attract another weightage equivalent to 10% of their Entrance Test (Online Test + PI, if any) score.
- ST (H) candidates of the State of Assam applying for admission in Diphu Campus, will be given Special Weightage equivalent to 20% of their Entrance Test (Online Test + PI, if any) score.
- A candidate applying for a particular PG program but has not studied the concerned subject with Honors / Pass at the Under Graduate level (in case permitted), then the aggregate percentage of marks of both Pass and Honors (in case of Honors student) or aggregate Pass marks (in case of Pass students) shall be considered for the additional award of 30% provided the candidate has completed his / her Graduation from colleges / institutes affiliated to Assam University.
- The Final score shall be calculated as per scheme given below:

### Silchar Campus

$$\text{Final Score} = \frac{\text{Raw Score} + \text{Honours Weightage} + \text{AU Weightage}}{90} \times 100$$

Raw Score = Marks obtained in the Entrance Test out of 50

### Diphu Campus

$$\text{Final Score} = \frac{\text{Raw Score} + \text{Honours Weightage} + \text{AU Weightage} + \text{ST(H) Weightage}}{110} \times 100$$

Raw Score = Marks obtained in the Entrance Test out of 50

- 13 All the candidates appearing entrance test are compulsorily required to submit scan copies of their class 10 (High School), 10+2 (Intermediate) and 10+2+3 (UG) examination mark sheets to the respective H.O.D. through email on the day of Test.
- 14 Those claiming reservation benefit as per GOI rules should submit scan copies of caste certificate/ valid NCL & EWS certificate as the case may be along with the documents mentioned at serial number 13 above.
- 15 All expenses concerning Entrance Examination shall be born out of the Application Fees collected from the Candidates and not from the Departmental Course Fee. For the purpose, the HoD may claim Rs. 5000/- or (number of applicants × Rs. 60/-), whichever is maximum from the competent authority through a proposal giving detail budget.
- 16 A student can apply maximum in two courses either in the same Department or in different Departments. However, he/she has to apply through separate application forms and requisite fees. Respective Departments / PIC conducting online test & PI should avoid time overlap in respect of such cases.
- 17 A student shall not apply simultaneously in Departments located at two different campuses.
- 18 A Departmental Admission Committee shall be formed in each Department and approval of the same may be obtained from the competent authority. One faculty member belonging to SC/ST category is to be included in the Departmental Admission Committee. In case there is no faculty member of SC/ST category available in the Department, any faculty member of SC/ST category from the same school may be included in the Departmental Admission Committee.
- 19 The Liaison Officer, SC/ST Cell through SC/ST representatives of the different Departmental Admission Committees shall monitor the overall implementation of reservation policy of GOI in the matter of Admission into PG courses.
- 20 Issues, if any, concerning Online Test and PI will be resolved in consultation with Mr. Sobhan Kumar Bedajna, System Analyst, COE Office, AUS.

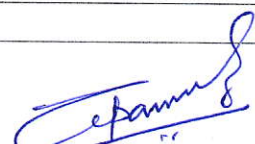
