At the outset the Vice-Chancellor being the Chairman of the Council welcomed Dr. Gautam Jha, School of Language Literature and Culture Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi for participating physically in the meeting as Visitor's Nominees and welcomed all other members for attending the meeting. Thereafter, agenda items were taken up for discussion and resolutions were adopted accordingly.

(A) Agenda item for confirmation:

Item No. 1: To confirm the Minutes of the 88th meeting of the Academic Council of AUS.

AC:89:11-21:1: The Minutes of the 88th meeting of the Academic Council of AUS of Assam University held on 20th July 2021 was made available to the members for perusal, consideration and confirmation.

Action Taken Report of the said meeting was also placed before the members and elaborated by the Registrar for consideration.

Resolution: The Council perused and confirm the minutes with following minor modifications and ATR of the meeting.

On item No, 30 of minutes of the 88th meeting of AC a Committee to be constituted with Controller of Examinations as Convener.

(B) Agenda item for ratification of the Council:

Item No. 2: Ratification of re-constitution of BPGS:

AC:89:11-21:2: The following BPGS were re-constituted with the approval of the Vice Chancellor and accordingly notified as follows:

- (i) BPGS in Chemistry was re-constituted and notified vide Notification No. AUK-212/15/2007/ dtd. 19th August 2021.
- (ii) BPGS in Bengali was re-constituted and notified vide Notification No. AUK-212/20/2007/ dtd. 19th August 2021.
- (iii) BPGS in Urdu was re-constituted and notified vide Notification No. AUK-212/20/2007/ dtd. 12th August 2021.

BPGS in Indian Comparative Literature was re-constituted and notified vide (iv) Notification No. AUK-212/20/2007/ dtd. 3rd August 2021.

The matter was placed before the Council for ratification.

Resolution: The Council ratified the same.

The matter was placed before the Council for ratification.

Resolution: The Council ratified the same.

Item No. 4: Ratification of re-constitution of School Board:

AC:89:11-21:4: An addendum in respect of re-constituted School Board of A. E. School of Physical Sciences was issued as follows:

An addendum in respect of School Board of A. E. School of Physical Sciences was notified vide Notification No. AUK-212/33/2011 dtd. 24th August 2021. The matter was placed before the Council for ratification.

Resolution: The Council ratified the same.

Item No. 5: Minutes of Examination Discipline Committee (EDC) meeting:

AC:89:11-21:5: The Controller of Examinations has forwarded the minutes of EDC meeting of Even semester 2020 dated 23-07-2021, Corrigendum odd semester 2019 dated 08-06-2020 & EDC minutes odd semester 2019 dated 03-07-2020 which was approved by the authority. The matter was placed before the Council for ratification.

Resolution: The Council ratified the same.

(C) Agenda item for approval of the Council:

Item No. 6: Matter related to NEP 2020:

AC:89:11-21:6: (a) Matter relating to implementation of NEP 2020:

The matter relating to implementation of NEP 2020 was placed in the 144th meeting (Special) of the Executive Council where it was resolved that progress on implementation of various aspects of NEP 2020 and particularly stressed on creation of Academic Bank of Credit and Lateral Entry and Exit to different Academic programmes.

The provision of lateral entry and exit already exists in certain academic programmes which need to be extended further. Prof. Sumanash Dutta, Working Chairman of Institutional Developmental Plan for NEP 2020 has been entrusted to devise ways and means for early creation of Academic Bank of Credit and enlarging the scope for lateral entry and exit into various academic programmes of the University.

On administrative understanding it is felt that the matter needs further elaborate discussion on the issue and the same being a major issue as of now, placed before the Academic Council for discussion and decision.

Resolution: The Council discussed the necessity of introducing ABC at the earliest and enlarging the scope of lateral entry and exit in various courses of the University. The Council directed to refer the matter to Working Chairperson of Institute Development Plan (IDP) Committee for preparing a detailed plan for initiation of the activities at the earliest.

AC:89:11-21:6: (b) Matter relating to initiatives of NEP 2020:

A meeting of Secretary (HE) with Vice Chancellors of Central Universities was held on 21st October 2021. Following action points emerged in the meeting:

- (i) Central Universities may include the NEP initiatives in their tripartite MoUs in such a way, so that progress can be monitored over time.
- (ii) University may encourage multidisciplinary and skill-based education in most of the discipline to the extent possible. Skill based courses in the area of Commerce & Accountancy as well as languages may be introduced.
- (iii) UGC may look into the eligibility criteria for participation in ABC, so that a large number of institutions can join the ABC.
- (iv) To the extent possible, all programmes in Higher Education may have multiple entry-exit facility. UGC has already issued guidelines on multiple entry-exit.
- (v) In developing SWAYAM MOOCs, UGC may coordinate with Central Universities, so that quality courses developed by a University can be offered by other Universities also.
- (vi) Activities related to NSS (National Service Scheme) / NCC (National Credit Corps) are already included in curriculum of some of the Universities. There is a need to assign credits to these activities. University may offer credit based courses on NCC following the guidelines of UGC.

Resolution : The Council directed to refer the matter to Institute Development Plan (IDP) Committee for preparing action plan in this regard.

AC:89:11-21:6: (c) Proposed new courses under NEP 2020:

(i) Under skill enhancement Program University will start initially one month certificate course on weaving, bamboo, cane and mushroom cultivation under the department of Fine arts, Agricultural Engineering and Management. This will protect the cultural heritage of different tribes of north east. The product may be sold in the fest. The trainee will get certificate and they will become entrepreneur with or without help of the government. The course may be extended to six month certificate course or one year diploma courses. Photography, journalism, painting and sculpture one month course may be stated for self-employment and develop new entrepreneur and University is planning to start from 2022 session.

- (ii) University is planning to start Insurgency and International Peace as an elective paper in Political Science Department. The classes will be taken by CIJW staff.
- (iii) University will extend existing six month diploma course to one year advance diploma course. The students who completed six month course in CIJW are eligible to take admission. Teachers of the Political Science department, Assam University will extend their services by taking classes in CIJW. This will start from 2022 session.

Resolution: The Council approved the same. However, concerned Departments are expected to design the curriculum in a manner which has utility in perspective of NIRF and NAAC. Vetting of the programme to be obtained from the Director, IQAC.

AC:89:11-21:6: (d) PG/UG/Integrated proposed new course structure:

The Controller of Examinations has forwarded the proposal of PG/UG/Integrated proposed new course structure.

PG COURSE STRUCTURE

All departments are to revise their syllabus as per the following structure. The new syllabus is to be implemented from 2022 session.

Proposed PG syllabus structure under NEP:

Sem I

There will be lateral exit (Certificate will be awarded) after first six months.

There will be 5 papers of six credits each.

One paper must be a skill enhancement paper.

Sem II

There will be lateral exit (Diploma will be awarded) after one year i.e two semesters) There will be 5 papers of six credits each.

Paper 203 will be inter-disciplinary; can be opted from any other department of the university, or from Swayam platform or any other university who is offering the course and MoU with the university or in the consortium.

Paper 204 is also open course students can take it from his/her department or from other department

Sem III

There will be 5 papers of six credits each.

303, 304, 305 will be elective papers.

305 will be practical paper for Science and dissertation / theoretical paper for others.

The course 303 may be opted from Swayam platform or any other university who is offering the course.

There will be no lateral exit in this semester.

Sem IV

There will be 5 papers of six credits each.

403, 404, 405 will be elective papers.

405 will be dissertation paper. If a student publishes a paper in a journal included in UGC care list out of research work carried out during the course duration, which can be submitted in lieu of project dissertation. Evaluation will be done above 80% and viva and others will be done as usual. Degree will be awarded after completion of 4 semesters.

Note:

- 1. Swayam courses are of 3 credits. In lieu of a regular course, two courses must be opted from Swayam platform. Swayam courses in lieu of an elective paper will be suggested by the department concerned. Open courses may be opted as per student's choice.
- 2. For practical courses, some practical may be adopted from virtual laboratories of lab platform of Ministry of Education, Govt. of India.

The matter was placed before the Academic Council for discussion and decision.

Resolution : The Council deliberated on the need of revision of the Courses and stressed upon tuning the same as per NEP 2020. However, CoE stressed on the need of the revision as an intermediate arrangement till the students are graduated from UG programme in tune with NEP 2020. The Council thereafter approved the same as an intermediate arrangement till course curriculums of PG are required to be made as per NEP 2020. The Council further recommended the same to the Executive Council for final approval.

Item No. 7: Matter related to Revision of LLM Syllabus in Law:

AC:89:11-21:7: The Dean, DCR School of Legal Studies has submitted the proposal for revision of LLM Syllabus in Law. The Dean will place the syllabus in the meeting.

The matter was placed before to the Council for consideration and approval.

Resolution: The Council discussed the matter and decided to drop the item.

Item No. 8: Matter related to the approval of Panel of Paper Setters, Evaluator of 1st and 3rd Semester LLM:

AC:89:11-21:8: The Dean, DCR School of Legal Studies has submitted the Panel of Paper Setters, Evaluator of 1st and 3rd Semester LLM, in sealed cover for consideration.

The matter was placed before the Council for approval.

Resolution : The Council accepted the same and recommended to the Executive Council for approval.

Therefore, the Council resolved that the Ph.D. from any UGC recognized University shall be one of the eligibility criteria for admission into D.Sc./D.Litt. Programme. The Council further recommended the same to the Executive Council for final approval.

Item No. 29: The Minutes of the 62nd meeting of the Affiliation Committee:

AC:89:11-21:29: Director, CDC placed the Minutes of the 62nd meeting of the Affiliation Committee to the Academic Council for consideration and approval of the Council.

Resolution: Director, CDC placed the matter with a correction that the Minutes of the Affiliation Committee mentioned in the agenda item will be 61st meeting. Also he informed that from this session Science stream has been started in two degree College under Assam University viz, Patharkandi College and Maibang Degree College. The Director, CDC also informed the Council that a notice has been issued by the Commissioner & Secretary, Dept. of Education, Govt. of Assam regarding affiliation of Model Degree College, Diether, Dist. Karbi Anglong under Dibrugarh University. As the Karbi Anglong district is under jurisdiction of Assam University it is the clear violation of Act. of the Parliament. In this regard the Registrar has already written to the concerned Dept., Govt. of Assam but till date no response has been received. After detailed discussion, the Council decided that matter to be written to the Education Minister, Govt. of Assam on affiliation to Model Degree College, Diether. After that if there is no response then the matter to be forwarded to the UGC.

AC:89:11-21:30: The Controller of Examinations has forwarded the proposal for Special Examination of TDC (Non CBCS) Odd and Even semester will held for the session 2013-14 & 2014-15 along with the regular examination and it will be held in offline mode.

The matter was placed before the Academic Council for approval.

Resolution: The Council discussed the matter and approved the same. Exam shall be held along with the regular course. Candidates with maximum six papers as arrears will be eligible to appear subject to compliance of other norms. The Council further recommended the same to the Executive Council for final approval.

AC:89:11-21:33.6: Minor changes in TDC (CBCS) syllabus of Manipuri:

The Head, Dept. of Manipuri has forwarded a proposal for minor changes in TDC (CBCS) syllabus of Manipuri.

Resolution : The Council accepted the same and recommended to the Executive Council for approval.

AC:89:11-21:33.7: New PG syllabus of Manipuri:

The Head, Dept. of Manipuri has forwarded new PG syllabus of Manipuri.

Resolution: The Council discussed the matter and decided to drop the item.

AC:89:11-21:33.8 : Weightages offered to Assam University students during admissions to various courses':

Assam University has been providing additional weightage to students of affiliated colleges for admission in the University courses. While this has enlarged the scope for higher learning of the students of affiliated colleges but has restricted quality and participation of students from other states. This has been hampering the NIRF ranking and NAAC grading of the University.

Resolution: The Council stressed on the need for giving better scope to the students of the affiliated colleges for higher learning. However, the Council also discussed the matter in light of the need for admission of quality students across the country to ensure better NIRF ranking. The Council observed that in current year admission no change in

weightage is desirable at the moment as admission is already going on. However, in future the University may take step in accordance with changing policy of the Ministry of Education and may take part in limited manner in CUCET examination for greater number of courses for ensuring quality students across the country and for securing a scope of higher learning for weaker section of the students of affiliated colleges.

AC:89:11-21:33.9: Fixation of date, type of question and mode of odd semester examination, 2021 of PG/ UG/ Integrated course and TDC Odd Semester Non CBCS Examination, 2021:

Controller of Examination has placed the proposal for fixation of date, type of question and mode of odd semester examination, 2021 of PG/ UG/ Integrated course and TDC Odd Semester Non CBCS Examination, 2021 for consideration by the Council.

Resolution: After threadbare discussion, the member present in the Academic Council unanimously decided that PG/ UG/ Integrated Odd Semester Examination, 2021 will be held within 22nd January, 2022 to 15th February, 2022. The examination will be held in offline mode. Student will be required to answer one question from each unit. (Answer five questions taking one from each unit). It is also decided that TDC Odd Semester Non CBCS Examination, 2021 examination will be held in offline mode in the last week of January, 2022 and the type of question will be as per CBCS guidelines. The Council further recommended the same to the Executive Council for approval.

AC:89:11-21:33.10: Matter related to BUGS and School Board for Urdu:

Confusion has been raised whether the matter related to BUGS of Urdu should continue along with other subjects like Persian, Boro, Nepali, Mizo, Hmar etc languages as Urdu has a separate Academic Department in the University.

Resolution: The Council discussed the matter and resolved that ordinance may be amended to have a separate BUGS for Urdu similar to other courses having fully fledged academic departments in the University.
