NTA has recently published a Public Notice dated 09th February 2023 for conducting CUET (UG) 2023 vide https://cuet.samarth.ac.in.





- Examination will be conducted on multiple days in three shifts, depending on the number of Candidates and Subject choices.


Important Instructions:



- ii. Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate. In no circumstances, candidates will be allowed to fill more than one Application Form. Strict action will be taken, even at a later stage, against such candidates who have filled more than one Application Form.
- iii. Candidates must strictly follow the instructions given in the Information Bulletin and on the website https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/ Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified.
- iv. Candidates must ensure that the e-mail address and Mobile Number provided in the Online Application Form are their own or Parents/Guardians only as all information/communication will be sent by NTA through e-mail on the registered e-mail address or SMS on the registered Mobile Number only.
