The matter was placed before the Board for kind perusal and for consideration of review of the same, if any.

Resolution: The matter was discussed in detail and resolved that a Committee to be constituted to find out the lapses in Assam University under National Education Policy 2020 and to suggest modalities for other courses wherein applicable through this Committee. Visitor's Nominee suggested to form different committees for different issues to make the thing more clear and active under National Education Policy 2020. The Board accepted the suggestion and authorized the Vice Chancellor to implement the same.

Item No. 3: Recruitment to Government (Assam) departments through Universities in the state of Assam:

PB:20:11-20:3: Government of Assam vide meeting on 5th October 2020 with representatives of various Universities of the State resolved to entrust recruitment of various Government Departments of Assam through Universities of Assam. Accordingly, Assam University has been entrusted to hold examination for Social Welfare and Social Conservation Departments (Annexure - B). The responsibility of holding examination from advertisement to declaration of result shall lie with the University. The cost of holding examination shall be borne by the Assam State Government and accordingly Assam University has already submitted tentative budget as per the format provided by the State Government (Annexure - C). The entire process has to be completed latest by February 2021. The University is in the process of getting into an Agreement in this regard with the State Government. Matter was placed before the Planning Board for information.

Resolution: The members appreciated the action taken by the University on the issue and assured for extension of all support to the University on requirement. Matter noted by the Board.

Item No. 4: Assam University Wi-Fi Campus Networking:

PB:20:11-20:4: Assam University Wi-Fi Campus Network (AUWCN) is installed and commissioned under the project of MHRD/MOE in OPEX Model for a period of 5 (five) years.

The AUWCN is extended to all the Academic Departments of Silchar & Diphu Campus. It is further extended to all the Hostels, Health Centre, Examination, Library, Administration, Computer Centre, Bipin Chandra Paul Auditorium, Guest House, VC Bungalow, Warden Complex.

The AUWCN was laid on the AU Campus Fiber Network which was previously available. However, as the Campus Fiber Network is not available in the Residential Campus Area (excluding VC Bungalow & Guest House) the AUWCN could not be extended in the Residential Campus Area under the Project of MHRD/MOE.

As per the directive of MHRD/MOE, AUWCN was to be provided to the Academic Dept/Hostels/Guest House/Administration/Examination etc.

It is also desirable that the Quarter dwellers may be facilitated by extending the existing network or by creating a separate network which may be integrated to the existing NKN Network.

The matter was placed before the Board for discussion and decision.

Resolution: The Board discussed the matter and decided to forward the proposal to the Ministry for adequate budget considering all aspects and requirement.
