Item No. 1: Confirmation of Minutes of 20th Meeting of Planning Board held on 23rd November 2020:



- (i) Computer Centre : Course PGDIT (Post Graduate Diploma in Information Technology)
- (ii) Centre for Studies in Human Development.
- (iii) Bachelor of Vocational (B.Voc) Degree : (a) Food Processing & (b) Farm Machinery & Power Technology under SOT.

The matter was placed before the Board for perusal and for consideration of review of the same, if any.

Resolution: The members discussed in detail on the academic programmes offered by the University and observed little corrections in respect to adding D.Litt. in Sl. No. 4, 5, 11 & 50 and Ph.D. in Sl. No. 48. Also, regarding courses under Self Finance scheme the Board observed to add all Self Financing Courses of the University in the lot with the observation that the concrete policy to be framed on detail of the courses and the fees structure applicable. The Board was in the opinion that all matters to be referred to the Committee to be reconstituted alongwith representation from AUDC and report to be submitted to the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor.

Item No. 3: Intake capacity, diversity of students and students facilities:

PB:21:05-22:3: There are challenges for number of intake, diversity of students (out of state & out of country) and appropriate facilities to the students of the University for which number of steps required to be taken in respect to permanent infrastructure for boarding of students, transportation to and from University, providing of sufficient water and electricity, medical facilities, canteen etc. The facilities by the University towards the students considered not upto the mark and as such more funding is required to proceed further.

The matter was placed before the Board for perusal and for consideration and to suggest appropriate course of action to be initiated by the University.

Resolution: The members discussed in detail on the issue and it was observed that the last sentence of the 1st paragraph required to be modified whereas it is required to explore more facilities to be provided to the students specially for the ramps, toilets etc. for differently challenged students.

Item No. 4: Proposal for starting of new Departments/ Centres/Courses:

PB:21:05-22:4: The 91st meeting of the Academic Council vide resolution No. AC:91:04-22:34 and the 148th meeting of the Executive Council vide resolution No. EC:148:04-22:23-34 has recommended for starting of new Departments and Centres at Assam University Diphu Campus subject to consent from the concerned Ministry/UGC. The new departments as proposed for AUDC are:

- (i) Department of Education Science
- (ii) Department of Business Economics
- (iii) Department of Mass Communication
- (iv) Department of Hospitality & Tourism Management

Also the Department of Ecology & Environmental Science added later by the EC.

Opening of Centres as proposed:

- (i) Centre for Northeast Studies
- (ii) Centre for Entrepreneurship Development

The matter was placed before the Board for perusal and for consideration.

Addition if required:

- 1) Department of Civil Engineering
- 2) Department of Mechanical Engineering
- 3) Department of Electrical Engineering
- 4) Department of Para Medical Sciences

Resolution: The members had detail discussion for starting of new Departments/ Centres/Courses as proposed in 91st AC and 148th EC where as it was recommended for starting of Departments/Centres/Courses with consent from the concerned

Ministry/UGC. However, the Planning Board on summery of the discussion it was resolved that the entire matter be referred to Director, IQAC for their views with reference to the Vision documents of the University and the same shall be reported back to the Vice Chancellor at the earliest.

Item No. 5: Improvement in academic/teaching learning infrastructure

PB:21:05-22:5: The University has taken steps for developing new teaching learning process which are combination of lectures, tutorials, seminars, demonstrations and self studies etc. The University installed and commissioned Interactive Panel Devices for Twenty Nine(29) Academic Departments including Two(2) in Diphu Campus, and One in Computer Centre, One in Central Library and another one in Finance branch of Administrative building. Total expenditure thus incurred is Rs.1,84,84,023/-.

However, proposal for providing of same type of devices for all other remaining department is made for consideration. Also all departments are required to be provided with Camera Devices with an approximated cost of Rs.1.7 Lakhs /devices. Further, at least one "High-tech Teaching Learning Enabled Studio classroom" for all the Academic Depts. are necessary for development in academic field.

Most importantly, adequate number of faculties and non-teaching staff are required to be appointed to maintain the teaching-nonteaching ratio prescribed by the UGC.

The matter was placed before the Board for perusal and for consideration.

Resolution : The Board agreed to the proposal and approved the same for taking it up with the appropriate Ministry.

PB:21:05-22:7: The Director i/c, College Development Council has reported the following progress in Colleges affiliated with Assam University during the year 2020 and 2022:

- a) 2 New Govt. Model Degree Colleges, one at Borkhola and another at SultaniCherra started functioning under the affiliation of Assam University.
- b) 2 District Institute of Education and Training, one at Kalachand, Dima Hasao and another at Diphu started 2 year B.Ed Course under affiliation of Assam University.
- c) Bachelor of Science stream introduced in 2 Colleges, viz. Eastern Karbi Anglong College and Patherkandi College.
- d) Proposal of starting one new Degree College at Dholai, is under process. The permission from DHE, Govt. of Assam is yet to be received.
- e) Proposal of S.P.M. College for starting of 4 year B.A. B.Ed programme under composite college scheme is under process. The permission from DHE, Govt. of Assam is yet to be received.
- f) Opening of Bachelor of Science stream in S. V. College Chandkheera, and Maibong Degree College still pending due to non-appointment of faculty members.
- g) Proposal of opening of new streams/ introduction of new subjects at KNB College, Srigouri and R.G. Degree College are under process. The permission from DHE, Govt. of Assam is yet to be received.
