Regarding Item No. FC: 65/05, the tentative Revised Budget Estimates (RBE) under Salary and Recurring for the financial year 2022-23 as communicated by UGC has been discussed in the meeting and it has been informed to the members that University has sent request for re-allocation within the budget head of Pension and Pensionery benefits and Non-Salary head of the allocated amount of Rs. 4705.58 lakhs of the approved RBE under Recurring head (OH-31) vide e-mail dated 13th February 2023 and again on 23rd February 2023. This is because the University requires additional fund for disbursing pension arrears of conversion cases from CPF to GPF which was sought earlier under RE vide e-mail dated 13th December 2023 to the Ministry of Education.

The UGC representative in the meeting informed that it has already been taken up with the Ministry of Education and on receipt of approval for conversion from CPF to GPF as per order of the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court, the re-allocation as proposed will be intimated for implementation by the University.

Regarding Item No. FC: 65/06, the members have been informed that initiatives have been taken to utilize the grants under Capital Assets fully within the current financial year i.e. 2022-23.

Regarding Item No. FC:65/11, the members have been informed that a letter has been sent to the Ministry of Education for necessary direction to NERIST for grant of joining time pay to Prof. R.M. Pant.

Regarding Item No. FC:65/13, consideration for allowing Prof. Sumanash Dutta in GPF-cum-Pension Scheme, the item has been discussed in detail and the UGC representative has informed in the meeting that the matter has already been processed in UGC and the reply will be communicated at the earliest.

The Chairman requested the UGC representative to expedite the matter as the concerned faculty will be superannuating on 28.02.2023.


