- Discuss how Dr Ambedkar's views on Aryan Invasion Theory challenges the dominant narratives of North-South binary.
- Discuss how his views on unifying force of Indian national ethos challenges the dominant narrative of sub nationalism.

Relevance in Contemporary Times:

- Examine how Dr. Ambedkar's vision remains pertinent in addressing contemporary challenges related to nationalism, identity, and social harmony.
- Discuss potential applications of his ideas in the context of current sociopolitical scenarios.

Methodology: The seminar will employ a multidisciplinary approach, combining historical analysis, legal studies, sociological perspectives, and philosophical inquiry. Keynote speeches, panel discussions, and paper presentations will be utilized to foster a comprehensive understanding of Dr. Ambedkar's vision.
