Minutes of 173<sup>rd</sup> Meeting of the Executive Council held on 13<sup>th</sup> February 2025 at 11.00 a.m. in the Hemanga Biswas Committee Room of the Vice-Chancellor's Secretariat, Assam University, Silchar.

At the outset the Vice-Chancellor and the Chairman of the Executive Council welcomed all the members for attending the meeting offline and online.

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Thereafter the meeting formally started with following agenda items which were taken up for discussion and resolutions were adopted accordingly.

#### (A) Agenda item for confirmation:

Item No. 1: Confirmation of the minutes of the 170th, 171st & 172nd meeting of the Executive Council:

**EC:173:02-25:01:** The minutes of the 170<sup>th</sup> Meeting, 171<sup>st</sup> Meeting (Special) and 172<sup>nd</sup> Meeting(Special) of the Executive Council held on 25<sup>th</sup> October 2024, 26<sup>th</sup> November 2024, and 9<sup>th</sup> January 2025 respectively were placed in the meeting for consideration and confirmation.

**Resolution:** The minutes of the 170<sup>th</sup> Meeting, 171<sup>st</sup> Meeting (Special) and 172<sup>nd</sup> Meeting(Special) of the Executive Council along with Action Taken Report of the meetings were perused by the members and confirmed. However, regarding the item No. 21 of 172<sup>nd</sup> EC meeting vides resolution No. **EC:172:01-25:21** the Executive Council observed and corrected the said minutes as follows:

- Chairperson, BRS/Head of concerned Department shall allot a new Supervisor from the concerned Department in consultation with the research scholar and will be placed to the BRS for ratification;
- Such scholar will be super numeric to the existing number, if there is no vacancy;
- Until the super numeric number is adjusted and a normal vacancy is created, the assigned new Supervisor/Co-supervisor cannot take any student;
- In considering the IPR issue, the original Supervisor and Co-supervisor (if under suspension) will become co-supervisor and enjoy equal rights on IPR. However, if the original Supervisor/Co-Supervisor reinstate her/is duty before Viva-Voce, their names will be included as Supervisor/Co-Supervisor and the newly appointed supervisor will become Co-supervisor.

Further, the Council authorised the Vice-Chancellor to allot a new Supervisor in consultation with the concerned Head and the research scholar for further necessary action that will be ratified in the next BRS.

#### (B) Agenda item for approval/decision :

Item No. 2: Confirmation of Service of Teachers (Silchar Campus):

**EC:173:02-25:02**: It has been found that the following faculty members of Silchar Campus has already completed one year of service as stipulated in the terms and condition of offer of appointment as per the date indicated against their names. It has been verified administratively about the satisfactory performance of concerned faculty.

In pursuance of the provisions of Clause 11 of the UGC Regulations of "Minimum Qualification for Appointment of Teacher and Other Academic Staff in Universities and

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Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standard in Higher Education, 2018" the teachers are found eligible for confirmation.

**Resolution:** The confirmation of Service of Teachers of Silchar Campus of the University as placed in the agenda were approved by the Council.

#### Item No. 3: Change of nomenclature of the post of Assistant in Assam University:

EC:173:02-25:03: The employees holding the position of Assistant in the University have applied for change of nomenclature of their position from Assistant to Assistant Section Officer (A.S.O.) without any financial up gradation. This is made with reference to DoPT order F. No. 21/12/2010-CS(P) dtd. 21-12-2015 whereby some other Non Secretarial Organisation and Autonomous Bodies under the MoE already adopted the said changes of nomenclature. Also the 165th meeting (Special) of the Executive Council vide its resolution No. EC:165:03-24:21 has approved the proposal of change of nomenclature from Assistant to Assistant Section Officer (ASO) and the copy of the Recruitment & Promotion Rule 2023 was duly forwarded to the concerned Ministry with a copy to UGC for their consent.

The copy of the application made by the employees, relevant minutes of the 165th EC meeting and relevant part of Recruitment Rules of non teaching employees along with other supporting documents shall be placed in the meeting for perusal of members.

The matter was placed before the Council for consideration and approval of the change of nomenclature from Assistant to Assistant Section Officer (ASO) without any financial up gradation.

**Resolution :** The issue related to change of nomenclature of the post of Assistant in Assam University was discussed in detail and after consideration of all pros and cons of the issue with reference to DoPT guideline dtd. 21-12-2015, the evidence of implementation of the same by other Central Government Organizations and Autonomous Bodies also in consideration with the resolution of 165th meeting (Special) of the Executive Council vide No. EC:165:03-24:21, the members were of the opinion that the same may be made effective with immediate effect without any additional financial implication. Further, it was directed that the Item No. 21 of the 165th meeting of the Executive Council shall have the correction as Non-Teaching Recruitment & Promotion Rule 2023 may be read as **Non-Teaching Recruitment & Promotion Rule 2024.**

The award of degrees for the 22<sup>nd</sup> Convocation of Assam University was accepted by the 98<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Academic Council vide resolution No. **AC:98:02-25:2** and recommended to the Executive Council for approval.

**Resolution :** The Council approved the conferment of degrees in the 22<sup>nd</sup> Convocation as placed in the meeting.

## Item No. 5: Special Examination for beyond the validity of the TDC (Non-CBCS) program:

EC:173:02-25:05: The Examination Branch has received a number of applications from students whose validity for the program were already exhausted for different reasons, it is proposed to conduct an additional special examination for all such students. The matter was accepted by the 98th meeting of the Academic Council vide resolution No. AC:98:02-25:03 and recommended the same to the Executive Council for approval.

**Resolution**: The Council approved the proposal.

#### Item No. 6: Panels of examiners for evaluation of Ph.D. Thesis:

EC:173:02-25:06: It is observed that the lists of panels of examiners submitted for evaluation of Ph.D. thesis by some supervisors are from the college where PG programs are not offered in the concerned department. As per university rule, the thesis is evaluated by external examiner in the rank of Associate and above from University/College where PG programs are being offered. The existing rule may be continuing in future.

The matter was accepted by the 98th meeting of the Academic Council vide resolution No. **AC:98:02-25:04** and recommended the same to the Executive Council for approval.

**Resolution:** The Council approved the item subject to following of provisions of the concerned Ordinance.

#### Item No. 7: Award of Grace marks:

EC:173:02-25:07: 1% of end semester total mark shall be awarded as grace marks to all semesters examinations of all programmes subject to passing of semester(s) after award of grace marks.

The matter was accepted in the 98<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Academic Council vide resolution No. **AC:98:02-25:06** and accordingly grace mark will be awarded semester wise, if applicable irrespective of number of papers to the maximum tune of 1% of the total mark of that particular semester and thereupon recommended to the Executive Council for approval.

**Resolution:** The Council approved the award of grace marks semester wise to the tune of 1% of the total marks of that semester subject to requirement without any restriction to no. of papers.

#### Item No. 8: Reallocation of Postgraduate Certificate Course in French:

EC:173:02-25:08: The Head, Dept. of Hospitality & Tourism Management (DHTM) has submitted a proposal with the approval of Departmental Advisory Committee (DAC) for reallocation of Postgraduate Certificate Course in French. The course, which was accepted by the Academic Council in its 91st meeting vide resolution No. AC:91:04-22:23 and subsequently approved by the 149th meeting of the Executive Council vide resolution No. EC:149:05-22:06 was under the Dept. of French.

The DAC, DHTM, was of the opinion that the course may be shifted from the French Department to the Department of Hospitality & Tourism Management. It is also been requested that this course shall be included in the forthcoming prospectus for the

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academic year 2025-2026 as an additional course offered by the Dept. of Hospitality & Tourism Management.

The matter was accepted by the 98th meeting of the Academic Council vide resolution No. **AC:98:02-25:09** and recommended the same to the Executive Council for approval.

**Resolution**: The Council approved the proposal.

#### Item No. 9: Proposal for amendment of Regulations on Endowment Funds:

EC:173:02-25:09: Assam University has been awarding 44 numbers of endowments in convocation from 44 Endowment Funds created by public donation on the basis of Endowment Fund Regulations. As per EC resolution No. EC:119:05-18:54.1, dated 5th June 2018, all donors who contributed less than one lakh were requested to deposit additional amount so that capital fund may be raised at least up to one lakh for each Endowment. The purpose was to generate atleast a considerable amount of interest for the award. Most of the donors have responded and deposited additional amount. However, 10 (ten) numbers of donors did not respond in spite of issuing of reminder. Moreover addresses of 5 (five) numbers of donors/their respective legal heirs could not be traced and accordingly a public notice was issued through the University website. Two donors having three Endowment Funds and one donor for one Endowment expressed their willingness to withdraw the fund from the University.

A Sub-Committee viz. **Endowment Fund Regulations Drafting Committee** has examined all the issues and made the following recommendations:

- 1. Since Endowment Funds in the University are operational through different regulations, all concerned regulations are to be amended as follows:
- (a) Due to non-cooperation from the donors or legal heirs the 15 numbers of Endowment Funds may be abolished within three years distributing the capital and as well as interest accrued in the three different installments to the endowment prize awardees. The list of endowment Fund shall be placed in the meeting.
- (b) There are 23 numbers of Endowment Funds having minimum of one lakh as capital amount for each. The same will continue as regular funds. The list of such endowment funds shall be placed in the meeting.
- (c) Two Endowment Funds having two lakhs or more as capital amount. The details shall be placed in the meeting. These may be continued as regular Endowment Fund
- (d) The donors of the four Endowment Funds (One having three funds) have expressed their willingness to withdraw the existing fund to discontinue the awards. Their Endowments may be discontinued and amount along with interest if any be returned. The details of the said funds shall be placed in the meeting.
- **2.** As recommended by Assam University Endowment Fund Regulations Drafting Committee the following provisions may be adopted for smooth and easy operation of the Endowment Funds.
- (a) All the Endowment Funds with one lakh and above capital each may be clubbed into a single fund and interest accrued may be distributed proportionately among the prize holders except Gold medal prizes.

- (b) The Endowment Fund with one lakh may remain valid for 10 years so that after 10 years the funds position may be reviewed.
- (c) To implement the above changes the existing endowment Regulations may be amended to the extent of above proposals.

The matter was accepted by the 98th meeting of the Academic Council vide resolution No. AC:98:02-25:10 with minor change with respect to point/clause No. 2(b) whereby the period of review has been reduced to 05 (five) years and there upon and recommended the same to the Executive Council for approval.

**Resolution:** The Council approved the recommendation of the Committee as placed in the agenda.

Item No. 10: Minutes of the 58th (Special) Joint Meeting of the BRS (Science) & BRS (SSH), is slated on 10th February 2025

**EC:173:02-25:10:** The minutes of the 58<sup>th</sup> (Special) Joint Meeting of Board of Research Studies (Science) & (SSH), slated on 10<sup>th</sup> February 2025 were placed in the meeting for consideration and approval by the Council.

The matter was accepted by the 98th meeting of the Academic Council vide resolution No. **AC:98:02-25:11** and recommended the same to the Executive Council for approval.

**Resolution:** The Council approved the minutes of the 58th (Special) Joint Meeting of Board of Research Studies (Science) & (SSH).

#### Item No. 11: Matter related to Supplementary Examination for PG departments

EC:173:02-25:11: The Report of the Committee on Supplementary Examination for PG departments was placed in the 20<sup>th</sup> SCAC meeting and it was subsequently placed in 170<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Executive Council whereby it was decided vide resolution No. EC:170:10-24:11(I) that the decision of the SCAC under resolution No. SCAC:20:09-24:1 (a) shall be referred back to the Academic Council for wider participation and deliberation before final approval:

The recommendation of the Committee is as below placed for perusal of the members.

- i) Department/Examination Section shall publish the result of even semester within 40 (forty) days of the end of semester end examination.
- ii) Supplementary exam shall be held at a time for all the PG Depts. preferably between 45 60 days after the end of even semester exam.
- iii) The supplementary exam shall be held for N/2 +1 papers where N stands for no. of semester in the programme.
- iv) Student shall have choice to select any paper for supplementary exam subject to maximum number of N/2+1 papers.

The 98<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Academic Council vide resolution No. AC:98:02-25:12 has accepted the proposal of Supplementary Examination for PG departments with minor modification in Point (i) whereas it shall be 30 (Thirty) days in place of 40 days and in Point No. (ii) it shall be maximum of another 30 days (i.e, total 60 days) from the date of completion of examination. The Council recommended the same to the Executive Council for approval.

**Resolution:** The Council approved the proposal of Supplementary Examination for PG departments as minuted in the 98th meeting (Special) of the Academic Council with the observation that the agenda as placed shall be read as "Further supplementary examinations shall be held only for students who have appeared the final end-semester examination of the course" which shall be from the Academic Session 2025-2026 and the same shall be effective for the PG, UG & Integrated course of the University campus.
