***(A) Agenda item for approval/decision by the Council:***

**Item No. 1 :Consideration of 32<sup>nd</sup> Annual Report for the year 2024-25:**

**Resolution:** On perusal of the Annual report by the members, the Executive Council considered and approved the 32<sup>nd</sup> Annual Report (Bilingual) of the University for the year 2024-25 and directed the Registrar to submit the Annual Report of the University to the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India for placing before both the Houses of Parliament.

**Item No. 2: Approval of the recommendations of 74<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Finance Committee of Assam University slated on 17<sup>th</sup> December 2025:**

**Item No.4 : Fixation of date of meeting of the Court :**

**EC:179:12-25:04 :** The 23<sup>rd</sup> Convocation of the University is scheduled on January 19-21, 2025. In this regard, a meeting of the Court is necessary.

The matter was placed before the Council to fix a date for meeting of the Court of the University.

**Resolution:** As per the Statute of the University under Clause 11(3), the date for holding of the Court meeting of the University shall be fixed by the Executive Council and accordingly the members of the Council after discussion authorized the Vice Chancellor to fix a date for holding of the Court meeting of the University.

**Item No.5: Establishment of Department of Assamese at Assam University Silchar campus:**

**EC:179:12-25:05 :** The University has received a copy of the letter endorsed to it on item referred to above. The letter dated 12<sup>th</sup> November 2025 has been written by UGC to MoE. The letter was placed in the meeting for perusal of the Council for necessary direction.

**Resolution:** The Executive Council took note of the UGC communication vides letter No. F.No.13-9/2023 (CU)/131217 dated November 12, 2025 addressed to the Under Secretary, DHE, MoE, a copy of which was endorsed to Registrar, Assam University. The Council agreed to comply with the standard conditions set for compliance to the University. Accordingly, the Council authorized Registrar to communicate the Ministry and request for early sanction of the Department. It was also resolved to request the Ministry to accord sanction of the salary amount along with sanction of the post. Further, the Ministry shall be requested for providing funds for creating adequate physical infrastructure for early commencement of classes.

**Item No. 18 :Any other item with the Permission of the Chair :**


**EC:179:12-25:18 : Complaints of financial impropriety against Sri Pinakpani Nath Purkyastha, Assistant Registrar**

The Registrar of the University was authorized by the Chair to place the item. Accordingly, it was reported by the Registrar that several complaints of irregular financial transactions against Sri Pinakpani Nath Purkyastha, AR was received by the office of Registrar. Following this, a two members fact finding committee was constituted for preliminary inquiry into the issue of alleged irregular financial transactions.

**Resolution:** The Council, based on the recommendations of said 2-member Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor approved to place the concerned official Sri Pinakpani Nath Purkyastha under suspension for 90 days with immediate effect pending inquiry in accordance with CCS (CCA) Rules 1965 and Assam University Acts and Statutes, as prima facie evidences were found to be against him. From the Report of the Committee, it was prima-facie evident that the concerned officer was found to act in violation of CCS Conduct Rules 1964.
