Kapili College, Kheroni, West Karbi Anglong	Opening of 4 th Year Honours in English, Assamese, Hindi, Political Science, Education, History, Philosophy, Economics and Nepali	As the College has fulfilled all the necessary requirements in accordance with the Undergraduate Research Programme (UGRP) of Assam University, Silchar, for the opening of the proposed subjects, the Committee resolved to accord permission to Kapili College to open the Fourth Year Honours under FYUGP in English, Assamese, Hindi, Political Science, Education, History, Philosophy, Economics and Nepali from the academic session 2026-27 .
2.	Rukasen College, Bakalia, Karbi Anglong	Opening of 4 th Year Honours in English, Political Science, Education, History Economics, Philosophy, Assamese, Hindi and Bodo	As the College has fulfilled all the necessary requirements in accordance with the UGRP of AUS for the opening of the proposed subjects, the Committee resolved to accord permission to Rukasen College to open the Fourth Year Honours under FYUGP in English, Political Science, Education, History, Economics, Assamese, Hindi and Bodo from the academic session 2026-27 . However, the Committee did not accord permission for opening 4 th Year Honours in Philosophy , as the College has not fulfilled the requisite requirements for the said subject.
3.	Langhin College, Langhin, Karbi Anglong	Opening of 4 th Year Honours in Assamese, Bodo, Economics, Education, English, History, & Pol. Science	As the College has fulfilled all the necessary requirements in accordance with the UGRP of AUS for the opening of the proposed subjects, the Committee resolved to accord permission to Langhin College to open the 4th Year Honours under FYUGP in Assamese, Bodo, Economics, Education, English, History, and Political Science from the academic session 2026-27

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4.	Ramkrishnan Nagar College	Opening of 4th Year Honours in Political Science, Philosophy, Bengali, English, Hindi, History, Economics, Sociology, Sanskrit, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics Also, Opening of 4th Year Honours with research in Bengali, English, Hindi, History, Economics, Sociology, Sanskrit, Physics and Chemistry	As the College has fulfilled all the necessary requirements in accordance with the UGRP of AUS, for the opening of the proposed subjects, the Committee resolved to accord permission to Ramkrishna Nagar College to open the Fourth Year Honours under FYUGP in Political Science, Philosophy, Bengali, English, Hindi, History, Economics, Sociology, Sanskrit, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics from the academic session 2026-27: However, the Committee did not accord permission for opening the Fourth Year Honours with Research in any of the proposed subjects during the academic session 2026-27. The Committee further recommended that the College may apply for permission to introduce Fourth Year Honours with Research from the academic session 2027-28,
5.	M. K. Gandhi College	Opening of 4 th Year Honours in Bengali, Political Science and Arabic	As the College has fulfilled all the necessary requirements in accordance with the UGRP of AUS, for the opening of the proposed subjects, the Committee resolved to accord permission to M. K. Gandhi College to open the Fourth Year Honours under FYUGP in Bengali, Political Science and Arabic from the academic session 2026-27.
6.	Govt. Model College, Borkhola	Opening of Honours with research in Sociology	The Committee reviewed the application submitted by the said College and, after reviewing the case, observed that the requisite conditions prescribed under the UGRP of AUS has hitherto not been fulfilled, and thus resolved not to accord permission to the College to open the Fourth Year Honours with Research in Sociology under the FYUGP from the academic session 2026-27.
7.	Cachar College, Silchar	Opening of Honours in Manipuri	The Committee reviewed the application of the Cachar College and, upon being satisfied that the requisite conditions prescribed under the UGRP of Assam University, Silchar, have been fulfilled, resolved to accord permission to open Fourth Year Honours in Manipuri under

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			FYUGP from the academic session 2026–27 .
8.	Nehru College, Pailapool	Opening of Honours with research in Bengali	As the College has fulfilled all the necessary requirements in accordance with the UGRP of AUS for the opening of the proposed subjects, the Committee resolved to accord permission to Nehru College to open the Fourth Year Honours with research under FYUGP in Bengali from the academic session 2026–27 .
9.	Patharkandi College, Patharkandi	Opening of Honours with research in Botany	After reviewing the application, the Committee resolved not to accord permission for opening Fourth Year Honours with Research in Botany , as the College has not fulfilled the requisite requirements prescribed under the UGRP of AUS.
10.	Karimganj College, Sribhumi	Opening of Honours with research in Chemistry and Commerce Also, Opening of Honours in Biotechnology	As the College has fulfilled all the necessary requirements in accordance with the Undergraduate Research Programme (UGRP) of Assam University, Silchar, for the opening of the proposed subjects, the Committee resolved to accord permission to Karimganj College to open the Fourth Year Honours with research under FYUGP in Commerce from the academic session 2026–27. However, in respect of Chemistry, permission to open the Fourth Year Honours with Research shall be granted only after receipt of a favourable inspection report from the Inspection Commission to be constituted for this purpose. The Committee also reviewed the application submitted by Karimganj College for permission to open the Fourth Year Honours in Biotechnology under the FYUGP from the academic session 2026–27. After detailed consideration of the proposal and the documents furnished by the College, the Committee observed the following: i. The Department of Biotechnology of Karimganj College does not have an adequate number of permanent faculty members, and thus does not fulfil 7/A of the UGRP of AUS. The list of faculties furnished by the College against the department comprises mostly the Guest Faculties.

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			ii. The permanent faculty members shown against the Department of Biotechnology are from the Department of Botany. The Committee expressed serious concern regarding the feasibility of conducting satisfactory classes for both Botany and Biotechnology, particularly with regard to the proper allocation of teaching workload and maintenance of the required credit-wise class routine as prescribed under the NEP 2020. In view of the above observations, the Committee observed that the requisite conditions for opening the Fourth Year Honours in Biotechnology have not been adequately fulfilled. Accordingly, the Committee resolved not to accord permission to Karimganj College to open the Fourth Year Honours in Biotechnology under the FYUGP from the academic session 2026-27.
11.	Lala Rural College, Lala	Opening of Honours with research in English, Bengali, Political Science, History, Economics and Commerce	As the College has fulfilled all the necessary requirements in accordance with the UGRP of AUS for the opening of the proposed subjects, the Committee resolved to accord permission to Lala Rural College to open the Fourth Year Honours with research under FYUGP in English, Bengali, History, Economics and Commerce from the academic session 2026-27
12.	Radha madhab College, Silchar	Opening of Honours in Commerce	After reviewing the application, the Committee resolved not to accord permission for opening Fourth Year Honours in Commerce for Radhamadhab College, for the academic session 2026-27 , as the College has not fulfilled the requisite requirements prescribed under the UGRP of AUS.
13.	Janata College	Opening of Honours with research in Economics	After reviewing the application, the Committee resolved not to accord permission to Janata College for opening the Fourth Year Honours with Research in Economics under the FYUGP from the academic session 2026-27 , as the College did not furnish the faculty bio-data in the prescribed format along with the application.

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14.	Srikishan Sarda College, Hailakandi	Opening of Honours with research in Physics	As the College has fulfilled all the necessary requirements in accordance with the UGRP of AUS for the opening of the proposed subjects, the Committee resolved to accord permission to Srikishan Sarda College to open the Fourth Year Honours with research under FYUGP in Physics from the academic session 2026-27
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Items from the Chair:

It was brought to the notice of the Committee by **Prof. Anup Kumar Dey, Additional Controller**, that certain anomalies had been noticed in the granting of permission for **Honours and Honours with Research** to the following colleges:

- Govt. Model College, Borkhola** – Honours with Research in Education
- Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Govt. Model College, Katlicherra** – Honours with Research in Education
- Srikishan Sarda College** – Honours in Commerce

After detailed deliberation, discussion, and thorough review of the applications and relevant documents of the concerned colleges, the Committee resolved to **withdraw the permissions** previously granted (vide notification no- AUD/CDC/NEP-2020/UGRP-2026/2 dated 14/08/2026) in respect of the above-mentioned subjects, in accordance with the provisions of the **Undergraduate Research Programme (UGRP) of Assam University, Silchar**, as follows:

- To withdraw the permission for **Honours with Research in Education** granted to **Govt. Model College, Borkhola** and **Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Govt. Model College, Katlicherra** for the academic session **2026-27**.
- To withdraw the permission for **Honours in Commerce** granted to **Srikishan Sarda College** for the academic session **2026-27**.

Candidates who have qualified for Honours/ Honours with Research from Assam University, if they wish to, may take admission in other affiliated colleges under Assam University, provided if they fulfill all other criteria. Such admission will be permitted subject to availability of seat in the concerned subject in the college of his/her choice. However, such candidate should contact the college and get ensured about seat availability in the subject before applying for transfer from one college to another. Before admitting in the student, college should intimate the examination section and update the data in the Assam Samarth portal.

For candidates who have qualified from other universities, the lateral entry to 7th semester may also be considered. For such candidates, however they should apply separately to Assam University, Silchar mentioning the subject and college of their choice. Such cases (i.e., outside AUS) will be considered only after verification of their degree and other credentials by Assam University. Only after getting permission from Assam University, the candidates may be considered for admission to the respective affiliated college(s).

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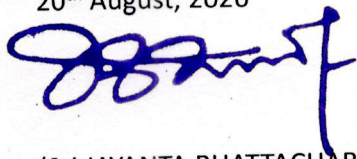
