Terms and conditions for compliance by the Allottee

- 1) The allottee has to occupy the allotted quarter within 07 (seven) days of issuance of allotment order under normal circumstances failing which applicable HRA & license fee will be deducted from the date of issue of allotment order.
- 2) In case of any major defects observed or any other compelling reason which makes the quarter unfit for occupancy, the allottee needs to immediately intimate the Engineering section as well as Estate section for necessary repair and renovation. In case of major defects, Estate Section may arrange a joint visit with the allottee within 7 (seven) days of allotment order. Joint visit will be conducted as per the date and time mutually agreed by Estate Section & allottee. If no apparent defects are found, the allottee must formally occupy the quarter within seven (7) days of receiving the allotment order. Failure to do so will result in deduction of applicable HRA and license fees from the date of issue of the allotment order, and these deductions will continue monthly unless otherwise decided by the Assam University. If occupancy occurs within seven days of receiving the allotment order, the deduction of HRA and license fees will commence from the date of occupancy.
- 3) Intimation of the allotment order will be provided to eligible applicants via hardcopy/email/WhatsApp message/publication on the Assam University website. The allotment order will be deemed received by the applicant on the earliest of the date of receipt of the hardcopy/email/WhatsApp message/publication on the Assam University website.
- 4) Furthermore, any applicant who declines to occupy the allotted quarter without providing a genuine reason or does not respond to the allotment order within stipulated time, such applicants will not be considered for any re-allotment for one year from the date of issue of allotment order. In addition, such allottee has to pay one-month applicable HRA and license fee. The vacant quarter in such cases will be allotted to the next eligible applicants, as decided by the Quarter Allotment & Advisory Committee (QAAC).
- 5) In case of major defects observed after allotment, allottee has to occupy the quarter (after necessary repairing & renovation) after issuance of fitness certificate by Engineering section and subsequent intimation by Estate Section to the concerned allottee, failing which deductions will be made (as per clauses mentioned above) after 07 (seven) days from such intimations.
